Application 1: Law Enforcement Grant

Total Requested: \$102,000 (Detailed cost information available on Project Cost and Deliverables (PCD) Spreadsheet in a separate document)

Proposed Project Description:

This cooperative agreement will assist in annual funding of federal law enforcement officers and support personnel in the protection of natural and cultural resources; the enforcement of off-highway motor vehicle laws; visitor services; and public health and safety at South Cow Mountain.

Accomplishments in Previous year:

From the previous grant, three law enforcement rangers were able to patrol around 188 days total on South Cow Recreation Area, thereby reducing the destruction of natural and cultural resources, being available for the public's safety and cutting back on vandalism to structures.

Application 2: Education/Safety Grant

Total Requested: \$55,000 (Detailed cost information available on Project Cost and Deliverables (PCD) Spreadsheet in a separate document)

Proposed Project Description:

Safety education funds for this project will provide new types of safety educational outreach for the visitors of South Cow Mountain Recreation Area. The funds will concentrate on educating the public on OHV safety, knowing the rules and regulations, and awareness of natural and cultural resources. Funding will support staff, contracts, materials and equipment.

Accomplishments in Previous year:
