

GOLDEN VALLEY WILDERNESS

36,464 Acres

***Designated October 31, 1994 by the California Desert Protection Act,
Public Law 103-433***

This is the final legal description as required in Section 103(b) of the above mentioned Act. It describes the boundary for the Golden Valley Wilderness Area located in San Bernardino County, California and managed by the Bureau of Land Management. The boundary is more particularly described as follows:

From the section corner of sections 1, 2, 11, and 12, T. 29 S., R. 42 E., Mount Diablo Meridian, said point being the point of beginning, being also the Naval Weapons Center boundary;

thence southerly, between sections 11 and 12, 13 and 14, 23 and 24, and 25 and 26, coincident with Naval Weapons Center boundary, to point 1, the section corner of sections 25, 26, 35, and 36;

thence easterly, between sections 25 and 36, coincident with Naval Weapons Center boundary, to point 2, the west 1/16 corner of sections 25 and 36;

thence southwesterly, leaving the Naval Weapons Center boundary, to point 3, the 1/4 corner of sections 35 and 36;

thence southeasterly, to point 4, the 1/4 corner of sections 36 and 1, on the township line between Ts. 29 and 30 S., R. 42 E.;

thence southerly, on the north/south centerline of section 1, T. 30 S., R. 42 E., to point 5, the intersection of a line parallel with and 30 feet northerly of centerline of a jeep trail, said intersection located in the south 1/2 of section 1;

thence westerly, parallel with and 30 feet northerly of centerline of said jeep trail, to point 6, the intersection of the north/south centerline of section 4;

thence northerly, on said centerline, to point 7, the 1/4 corner of sections 33 and 4, on the township line between Ts. 29 and 30 S., R. 42 E.;

thence westerly, on said township line, to point 8, the 1/4 corner of sections 32 and 5;

thence southerly, on the north/south centerline of section 5, to point 9, the intersection of a line parallel with and 30 feet northerly of centerline of a jeep trail, said intersection located near the center 1/4 corner of section 5;

thence northwesterly, parallel with and 30 feet northerly of centerline of said jeep trail, to point 10, the intersection of the range line between T. 30 S., Rs. 41 and 42 E.;

thence northerly, on said range line, to point 11, the township corner of sections 1, 6, 31, and 36;

thence northerly, on the said range line between T. 29 N., Rs. 41 and 42 E., to point 12, the 1/4 corner of section 36 only, T. 29 S., R. 41 E.;

thence westerly, on the east/west centerline of section 36, T. 29 S., R. 41 E., to point 13, the intersection of a line parallel with and 30 feet easterly of centerline of a jeep trail;

thence northwesterly, parallel with and 30 feet northeasterly of centerline of said jeep trail, to point 14, the intersection of the section line between sections 26 and 27;

thence northerly, between sections 26 and 27, and 22 and 23, to point 15, the 1/4 corner of sections 22 and 23;

thence westerly, on the east/west centerline of section 22, to point 16, the center-west 1/16 corner of section 22;

thence southerly, on the north/south centerline of the southwest 1/4 of section 22, to point 17, the southwest 1/16 corner of section 22;

thence westerly, on the east/west centerline of the southwest 1/4 of section 22, to point 18, the south 1/16 corner of sections 21 and 22;

thence northwesterly, to point 19, the center-east 1/16 corner of section 21;

thence northerly, to point 20, a saddle located in the northeast 1/4 of section 21, being easterly of a peak having an elevation of 3357 feet as shown on the USGS 7.5 minute Quadrangle "Klinker Mtn., Calif.", 1967 (photoinspected 1973);

thence northeasterly, to point 21, the intersection of a line parallel with and 30 feet southerly of the centerline of an east/west bearing jeep trail, and a line parallel with and 30 feet northeasterly of the southeasterly prolongation of the centerline of a northwesterly bearing jeep trail, said intersection located near the corner of sections 15, 16, 21, and 22;

thence northwesterly, parallel with and 30 feet northeasterly of the centerline of said jeep trail and its prolongation, to point 22, the intersection of the northerly edge of a wash, said intersection located in the southeast 1/4 of the southeast 1/4 of section 16;

thence northwesterly, to point 23, the center 1/4 corner of section 16;

thence easterly, on the east/west centerline of section 16, to point 24, the center-east 1/16 corner of section 16;

thence northerly, on the north/south centerline of the northeast 1/4 of section 16, to point 25, the northeast 1/16 corner of section 16;

thence westerly, on the east/west centerline of the northeast 1/4 of section 16, to point 26, the center-north 1/16 corner of section 16;

thence northerly, on the north-south centerline of section 16, to point 27, the 1/4 corner of sections 9 and 16;

thence northeasterly, to point 28, a hill located in the southeast 1/4 of section 9 and having NAD 1927 coordinates 35° 25' 23" N. latitude, 117° 35' 05" W. longitude, as scaled from the USGS 7.5 minute Quadrangle "Klinker Mtn., Calif.", 1967 (photoinspected 1973);

thence northeasterly, to point 29, a junction of washes, said junction having NAD 1927 coordinates 35° 25' 31" N. latitude, 117° 34' 41" W. longitude, as scaled from the USGS 7.5 minute Quadrangle "Klinker Mtn., Calif.", 1967 (photoinspected 1973);

thence southeasterly, to point 30, the southwest 1/16 corner of section 10;

thence northerly, on the north/south centerline of the southwest ¼ and the north/south centerline of the northwest ¼ of section 10, to point 31, the intersection of a line parallel with and 30 feet southerly of centerline of a jeep trail, said intersection located in the north half of the northwest ¼ of section 10, T. 29 S., R. 41 E.;

thence northeasterly, parallel with and 30 feet southeasterly of centerline of said jeep trail, to point 32, the terminus of said jeep trail in the southeast ¼ of section 3;

thence North to point 33, the intersection of the toe of a southerly slope, said point having a NAD 1927 N. latitude line of 35° 26' 09", as scaled from the U.S.G.S. 7.5 minute quadrangle "Klinker Mtn, Calif.", 1967 (photoinspected 1973);

thence westerly, to point 34, the most westerly of two knobs located in the SW ¼ of section 3 and having NAD 1927 coordinates of 35° 26' 11" N. latitude, 117° 34' 28" W. longitude, as scaled from the USGS 7.5 minute Quadrangle "Klinker Mtn, Calif.", 1967 (photoinspected 1973);

thence northeasterly, to point 35, the intersection of a line parallel with and 30 feet northerly of centerline of the most southerly jeep trail, and a line parallel with and 30 feet southerly of centerline of the most northerly jeep trail, said intersection having NAD 1927 coordinates 35° 27' 37" N. latitude, 117° 33' 56" W. longitude, as scaled from the USGS 7.5 minute quadrangle "Klinker Mtn, Calif.", 1967 (photoinspected 1973);

thence northeasterly, parallel with and 30 feet southerly of centerline of said jeep trail, to point 36, the intersection of a line parallel with and 30 feet southerly of centerline of a jeep trail, said intersection having NAD 1927 coordinates 35° 29' 14" N. latitude, 117° 29' 22" W. longitude, as scaled from the USGS 7.5 minute Quadrangle "West of Black Hills, Calif.", 1987 (provisional);

thence easterly, parallel with and 30 feet southerly of centerline of said jeep trail, to point 37, the terminus of said jeep trail, located near the center ¼ corner of section 21, T. 28 S., R. 42 E.;

thence southeasterly, to point 38, a peak located in the southwest ¼ of section 27, and having an elevation of 3164 feet as shown on the USGS 7.5 minute Quadrangle "West of Black Hills, Calif.", 1987 (provisional);

thence southeasterly to point 39, the intersection of the line between sections 27 and 34, with a line parallel with and 30 feet westerly of centerline of a jeep trail;

thence southeasterly, parallel with and 30 feet westerly of centerline of said jeep trail, to point 40, the intersection of the township line between Ts. 28 and 29 S., R. 42 E., being also the Naval Weapons Center boundary;

thence easterly, on said township line, coincident with Naval Weapons Center boundary, to point 41, the section corner of sections 1 and 2 only, T. 29 S., R. 42 E.;

thence southerly, between sections 1 and 2, coincident with Naval Weapons Center boundary, to the point of beginning.

END OF DESCRIPTION

The above description containing approximately 36,464 acres utilizes the Cuddeback Lake, Klinker Mountain, Red Mountain, and West of Black Hills 7.5 minute quadrangle maps prepared

by the U.S.G.S. The boundary calls listed herein are in part a result of scaling distances from said quadrangle maps and are not a result of survey. All courses have been depicted upon the above mentioned quadrangle maps and are made a part of this official record. Acreage is calculated from the CASO ArcInfo wilderness coverage.

I hereby certify the legal description and map herewith represent the location of the boundary of the Golden Valley Wilderness area designated by the California Desert Protection Act, Public Law 103-433 dated October 31, 1994.
