




DID YOU KNOW? _____

- 28 million American homes use electricity from hydropower
- 7% of the electricity produced in America comes from hydropower
- The average American household uses 10,000 kilowatt-hours of electricity per year

ROLE OF PUBLIC LANDS



- Approximately 550 hydropower projects are associated with BLM lands
- Over 6,400 megawatts of power are produced from FERC licensed hydroelectric projects associated with BLM lands
- 40 hydropower projects on BLM withdrawn lands will be re-licensed in the next 10 years
