

APPENDIX B

DEFINITIONS

Applicant	The Company submitting the SF 299 application form. The company who will be the holder of the ROW/TUP.
Applicant's Project Manager	The authorized representative of the applicant and the main point of contact for agencies and contractors.
BLM Project Manager	The BLM's point of contact for coordination with the Applicant's Project Manager, other agencies and contractors. The leader of the ID team. Also has the authority to issue any Stop Work Orders.
Federal Lands	All lands owned by the United States except lands held in trust for an Indian or Indian tribe, lands in the National Park System, and lands on the outer Continental Shelf.
Notice to Proceed (NTP)	A document that authorizes a company to begin construction of a specific spread(s) or segment(s) of the Project.
Plan of Development (POD)	A document which accompanies the ROW application which clearly describes what will be built, why it is needed, and how it will be constructed, operated, maintained and terminated.
Public Lands	The term public lands means any land and interest in land owned by the United States within the several States and administered by the secretary of the Interior through the Bureau of Land Management, without regard to how the United States acquired ownership, except, (1) lands located on the Outer Continental Shelf; and (2) lands held for the benefit of Indians, Aleuts, and Eskimos.
Related or Ancillary Facility	Those related structures, devices, improvements, and sites which are authorized under the Act and require the substantially continuous use of Federal lands for the operation and maintenance of the project. The facility need not be connected or continuous to the project and may be authorized under a separate ROW Grant or TUP.
Right of Way (ROW) Grant	A document authorizing a non-possessory, non-exclusive Right to use Federal lands for the limited purpose of construction, operation, maintenance, and termination of a pipeline per 43 CFR 2880.0-5(n), OR

	An instrument authorizing the use of a right-of way over, upon, under, or through public lands for construction, operation, maintenance and termination of a project per 43 CFR 2800.05(h).
Spread	A segment or contracting unit, of the project during construction.
Stipulations	The compilation of provisions and requirements of the terms and conditions of the ROW Grant/TUP.
Temporary Use Permit (TUP)	A revocable non-possessory authorization to use Federal lands in the vicinity of a ROW grant in connection with the construction, operation, maintenance, or termination of a <i>pipeline</i> per 43 CFR 2800.0-5(h), OR A revocable non-possessory, non-exclusive privilege, authorizing temporary use of public lands in connection with construction, operation, maintenance or termination of a project per 43 CFR 2800.05(i).
Third-Party Contractor	An agency's representative(s) who conducts necessary field inspections on all project lands to ensure the terms and conditions of the ROW Grant/TUP and Notice(s) to proceed are met.
