The Bureau of Reclamation has scheduled it's annual seminar on the Safety Evaluation of Existing Dams (SEED), and registration forms have been furnished to the Bureau of Land Management's State Engineers. The individual bureau reports of the Peer Group Evaluation of DOI dam safety programs will be released on or just after February 20, 1997.
