Subject: Availability of Video Conferencing System

The National Applied Resource Sciences Center now has available a PictureTel® Venue video conferencing system. The system is equipped with one camera and a Canon® document imaging system. It will accept input from most laptop personal computers or VCRs. To schedule use of this system, the four National Centers and the Colorado State Office personnel should call Rheda Dodd at 303-236-6454 or send her electronic mail to her GroupWise email address. Other State Offices wanting to schedule a video conference with one of the National Centers should also contact Rheda.

The video conferencing equipment can be moved easily to several locations within Building 50. These include three conference rooms and the three National Center Directors' offices. It will accommodate groups up to 15 people. It can connect to any of the similar systems within BLM. Group conferences involving three or more sites can also be scheduled.

When scheduling a video conference, please allow lead time for us to move and test the equipment in any of the available locations. A 3-day lead time should prove adequate.
