The National Applied Resource Sciences Center (NARSC) has prepared a revised map depicting current BLM administrative units, office locations, and public lands, entitled "BLM Public Lands and Administrative Jurisdictions." This map replaces the current version which was produced in 1996 and reflects recent BLM realignments. All administrative jurisdiction data was reviewed by Washington and State Office personnel. The map is primarily intended for internal use, and thus, no sales price has been established.
