The Minerals Management Service (MMS) has requested Native American Solid Minerals Information for its annual report, Mineral Revenues, 1999. This report addresses mineral production and revenues generated on federal and Indian lands.

We request your assistance in providing MMS with the number and total acreage by geographic state and commodity for all Native American solid minerals leases, licenses, mining permits, etc., under your supervision as of December 31, 1999, and the same information for those leases, etc., that were produced during calendar year 1999. Do not include any pending lease, license, or permit applications. The information will be consolidated with other States' data and sent to MMS. Please submit one table for total cases under supervision and for producing cases.
