Subject: Change in Mileage Rates for Privately Owned Vehicles

The purpose of this Information Bulletin is to alert Bureau of Land Management (BLM) travelers that the mileage allowance for a Privately Owned Vehicle (POV) for government travel has changed for all travel on or after January 22, 2001.

The General Services Administration (GSA) published Amendment 95 to the Federal Travel Regulation (FTR) in the Federal Register on January 22, 2001 in (Vol. 66, No.14). This amendment replaces 41 CFR, Part 301-10, of the Federal Travel Regulation regarding mileage allowances for POVs. The new mileage allowances for advantageous use of a POV are as follows:

Privately owned airplane	96.5¢ per mile
Privately owned automobile	34.5¢ per mile
Privately owned motorcycle	27.5¢ per mile

In addition to the above allowances, GSA has determined that the mileage allowance for a POV when a Government Furnished Vehicle (GFV) is not available is now 28.5¢ per mile. The allowance for a POV when you are committed to using an available GFV is still 10.5¢ per mile.
