The attached IM WY-2001-02 identified a problem at FY00 EOY of unspent Mining Law (1990) funds and 3809 work not completed. The solution presented for FY01 was that Afield offices must review all 3809 cases entered in LR2000. All required 3809 work must be programmed for and accomplished during the year. Cases determined suitable for closure must be field inspected and closed. Consider all options to do the work, including the use of mineral and non-mineral BLM specialists, temporary personnel, and contractors, if assistance is required.@
