ENTIRE STEENS MOUNTAIN LOOP ROAD OPEN

HINES, Oregon – The entire Steens Mountain Loop Road has been opened. Remaining snowdrifts were cleared earlier this week, and although road conditions have improved, travelers should still drive with caution. Avoid wet and muddy side roads, maintain safe speeds, and be aware of loose gravel and wash-boarded areas. Visitors are reminded the Loop Road is largely bordered by wilderness, where motorized travel is limited to designated open roads.

All campgrounds on Steens Mountain are open and in full service.
