## PROPOSED DECISION FOR STEENS MOUNTAIN TRAVEL MANAGEMENT PLAN RESCINDED

**HINES, Oregon** – The U.S. Bureau of Land Management (BLM) Burns District has rescinded the Finding of No Significant Impact and Decision Record/Proposed Decision for the Steens Mountain Travel Management Plan Environmental Assessment.

The decision to rescind is based on Judge Ann Aiken's June 8 Opinion and Order in Oregon Natural Desert Association's case against BLM's Andrews Management Unit and Steens Mountain Cooperative Management and Protection Area (CMPA) Resource Management Plans. The BLM intends to take into account Judge Aiken's opinion addressing requirements for the Steens Mountain CMPA Transportation Plan and reissue the Finding of No Significant Impact and Decision Record/Proposed Decision. The date for the reissue has not been determined.
