North Spit Docks Removed for Winter

NORTH BEND, Ore. – With fall and its accompanying storms here, the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) will remove the docks from the water at the North Spit boat launch on Wednesday, October 28.

“We can save the docks a lot of wear and tear if we store them on dry ground during the stormy season,” said Bob Golden with the BLM. The docks will be re-installed in early spring 2010.

The other facilities at the North Spit boat launch will remain open throughout the year.

About BLM
