BLM Recreation Sites Receiving Maintenance Upgrades

Roseburg, OR – The Bureau of Land Management’s Roseburg District Office has announced that from February 8 - 26, 2010 recreation sites at the Swiftwater and Wolf Creek Trailheads and the Swiftwater Day-use Area will be undergoing maintenance upgrades. During this maintenance period the sites may be closed to vehicles for several days at a time. Pedestrian traffic will be permitted outside the work area. A public notification will be made when the projects are complete
