Subject: Implementation of the Timber Volume and Value System on Microsoft XP Personal Computers

The Oregon State Office (OSO) and Northrop Grumman have successfully re-hosted the Timber Volume and Value System (TVVSPC) onto Bureau of Land Management personal computers as a Microsoft Windows XP application (now TVVSWIN). Effective July 3, 2006, TVVSPC Cruise Volume processing will no longer be available.

The Timber Volume and Value System data has been maintained and archived in the TIMBER database on an OSO server. Because this data is mission critical to the Oregon/Washington timber program, the OSO (using Northrop Grumman services) will provide training to districts using the system. The contract programmer (Cloy Bittinger) will be conducting training in the westside districts (including Klamath Falls) during May and early June 2006. A training schedule has been distributed to the westside District Cruiser/Appraisers. Training for the eastside districts will be provided on an as-needed basis.

The OSO will continue to maintain all archived data sets stored in each district's respective archive folder. The OSO will also have the ability to produce volumes through the legacy applications in the future. Legacy data produced prior to June 30, 2005, will require the assistance of the State Cruiser/Appraiser or the contract programmer. Eventually, these applications will be archived in the OSO.
