Subject: Informational Video: Fish Passage - Removing Barriers to Fish in the Pacific Northwest

I am pleased to present an informational video prepared by the Oregon State Office (OSO) on the subject of fish passage projects at stream crossings. It was prepared in coordination with staff at the Roseburg and Coos Bay Districts. The story line describes the magnitude of the issue in the Pacific Northwest, focuses on Bureau of Land Management lands in western Oregon, emphasizes the collaborative nature of our work due to land ownership patterns, and explains the process for designing and constructing fish-friendly culverts.
