Subject: Emergency Stabilization and Rehabilitation (ESR) Annual Monitoring Summary/Funding Request DD: 9/30/2009

Program Areas: Emergency Stabilization (2822) and Burned Area Rehabilitation (2881)

Purpose: The purpose of this IM is to request the annual monitoring summary reports for the 2007 and 2008 ESR projects, FY09 funding requests, and the final monitoring report for the 2006 ESR projects.

Policy/Action: The annual Monitoring Summary Reports for all 2007 and 2008 ESR projects that received 2822 and 2881 funding are due into the OSO by COB September 18, 2009. The reports are written on the "Monitoring Reports and Funding Request Form" (refer to BLM internal website <http://web.blm.gov/internal/wo-200/wo-220/ESR/> to download the required form). The purpose of these reports is to submit the results of the current year's ESR monitoring to the WO and request additional funding in 2822 and 2881 for FY2010. Use parts 1, 3, and 4 for projects from 2007 and 2008. Use Part 2 for projects from 2006. In addition, if all of the objectives for stabilization and/or rehabilitation on a 2007 or 2008 fire have been met and no further funding is needed for FY 2010, use Part 2 for a final close out report.
