Please submit hard copies of any new incumbent declarations not shown in the Unit Summary for staff in 401 positions only. Arrangements have been made in the State Office/Regional Office to review 401 incumbents.

Documentation for training completed by individuals in FY 2006 will be maintained at the unit level and reflected on the Unit Training and Development Summary. David and the other Implementation Team members are available to answer questions while you complete this assessment.

Attached are an Implementation Update, the 2007 Implementation Strategy for the Pacific Northwest, and the Supplemental Instructions for Entering IFPM data into IQCS.
