As residents of Griffin Creek Road we wish to express our concern about the proposed off road vehicle site for Anderson Butte. Our homes are located below a ridge with a road system coming off of Anderson Butte that occasionally has off road vehicle activity.

Over the years we have experienced many of the negative impacts of this use including noise, trash being thrown in areas where we hike and bicycle, target shooting and bonfires and fireworks during dry seasons.
