Dear Bureau Representatives,

I am writing to you to urge that the BLM drop plans for clearcutting in Oregon old growth forests and to respect the terms of the Northwest Forest Plan.

It is vitally important to:

- Protect all mature and old-growth forests from clearcutting;
- Continue to protect threatened and endangered species such as the marbled murrelet and the Northern spotted owl;
- Promote forest restoration rather than intensive industrial logging.
- Develop sustainable forestry rather than clearcutting;
- Protect trout, salmon and clean water by shielding watersheds, rivers and streams from sedimentation and temperature changes.

The draft WOPR needs to be revised to eliminate the proposed destructive provisions. I urge you to protect these forests and stay true to the intent and terms of the NWFP.
