I am very annoyed and dismayed by the proposed WOPR changes to management of BLM lands in Western Oregon. In these times of deepening environmental crisis, there is strong and growing public sensitivity to saving old growth forests, assuring clean water, mitigating climate change, protecting endangered species, and maintaining opportunities for high quality outdoor recreation. In this light, the WOPR proposals seem like a retreat into 1960's mentality.
