

**DECISION RECORD
and
FINDING OF NO SIGNIFICANT IMPACT**

- I. Decision:
BLM will remove empty drums and explosives from the site, and perform an initial characterization (soil sampling) to determine if petroleum contamination is present requiring further cleanup.
- II. Rationale for the Decision:
Removal and characterization will be accomplished to bring the Site into compliance with Federal and State of Alaska environmental regulations concerning hazardous and solid wastes. This will allow conveyance of the land to the Nelson Lagoon Village Corp.
- III. Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI):
Based on the analysis of potential environmental impacts contained in the attached environmental assessment, I have determined that impacts are not expected to be significant and an environmental impact statement is not required.
- IV. ANILCA Section 810 Compliance:
The proposed action will not significantly restrict Federal subsistence uses, decrease the abundance of federal subsistence resources, alter the distribution of federal subsistence resources, or limit qualified Federal subsistence user access from currently existing conditions. No further analysis is necessary at this time..
- V. Adverse Energy Impact Compliance:
This action has been analyzed as required by Washington Office Instruction Memorandum 2002-053 to determine if it will cause an adverse impact on energy development. The action will not have an adverse direct or indirect impact on energy development, production or distribution. The preparation of a Statement of Adverse Energy Impact is not required.
