The 2008 Ironwood Forest National Monument Special Recreation Permit program authorized use of public lands in connection with commercial recreational use. Permits were primarily for use of primitive roads and trails for commercial sightseeing, cattle drives and equestrian rides. The program generated approximately \$400 in fee revenues.

FEE SCHEDULE

Special Recreation Permit fees for commercial uses, competitive events, and organized groups are collected in accordance with the national fee schedule established by the BLM Director. Deductions for use on non-public land is allowed in accordance with permit regulations, depending on the type of use and use area.
