**DESCRIPTION:**

The Ironwood Forest National Monument Special Recreation Permit (SRP) Program authorizes use of public lands in connection with commercial recreational use. Permits are primarily for the use of primitive roads and trails for commercial trail riding.

**FEE SCHEDULE:**

The SRP fee schedule for commercial activities is established nationally for all BLM field offices. Fee receipts derived from recreational commercial, competitive, and organized group event SRPs are routinely calculated using national fee schedule guidance found in BLM Recreation Permit Administration Manual H-2930-1, Section III.G., as established by 43 CFR 2930.

**SPECIFIC ACCOMPLISHMENTS FOR FY09:**

**Wildlife Habitat Restoration, Resource Protection:**

No fee revenues were expended this year, but Federal appropriations were used to fund cultural resource surveys on routes in the use area for management and planning purposes.

**Visitor Services, Interpretation:**

No fee revenues were expended this year, but Federal appropriations were used to fund pre-application work with applicants and permit processing services.

**Law Enforcement, Public Use, and Recreation:**

No fee revenues were expended this year, but Federal appropriations were used to fund patrols in the use area.

**PROJECTS/ACTIVITIES PLANNED FOR FY10:**

Pending permit renewals will be processed using Federal appropriations. Fee revenues will be expended to produce visitor information for the permit use area, assist with signing and implementation of travel management plans for permitted activities.
