Subject Congressional Inquiry

Joanie, Just in case you get the urge to read your blackberry e-mail between innings, I wanted to let you know I responded to a call from Nick Matiella (Senator John McCain's Office) this afternoon. I apprised Elaine and worked with Bill Ruddick and Mike Werner to provide Nick with some information on the Saguaro National Park Exchange Project. Here is the contact report I submitted to the WO Weekly Report. P.S. Hope you don't see this e-mail until Monday morning. :)

Congressional Contact Report: On March 7, Nick Matiella from Senator John McCain's office in Washington called to request information on a BLM land exchange completed in 1998. BLM staff provided information on the specifics of the exchange and the parties involved. In summary, the BLM completed the Saguaro National Park Land Exchange Project on March 23, 1998. Through the exchange the United States acquired 632 of privately owned land within the West Unit of the Saguaro National Park. In exchange for the private parcel, exchange proponents - Tucson Mountain Investors, L.L.C. and El Rio Saguaro, L.L.C., acquired 4,322 acres of public lands in Maricopa County in the Lake Pleasant area.
