

# Paria Canyon/Coyote Buttes Vermilion Cliffs National Monument Fee Increase Proposal

The current fee structure has been in place since 1997, excluding the addition of the \$5.00 lottery application fee in May 2007. There has been a steady increase in visitor use, and a corresponding increase in operational costs. The increase in visitation has resulted in additional revenue, which so far has been used successfully to offset operational costs. The BLM projection is that total revenue will exceed expenditures within the next couple of years, eliminating project funding used to maintain trailheads, sign repair and replacement, and public service upgrades.

Visitors will directly benefit from these fee increases. The operational costs of sustaining the facilities and settings necessary for the visitor's desired outcomes are being met by existing revenues with the small surplus being used for proposed projects such as updating and expanding the trailheads, campgrounds, and providing navigation guides and flood education. Continued improvements will not be possible without additional revenue.
