Subject: Notice of "Freezing" On-line Recordation and Case Access (ORCA), Case Recordation (CR), Mining Claim Recordation System (MCRS), Legal Land Description (LLD), and Status

Attached is the subject notice for posting in your Information Access Centers. Pending conversion to the Legacy Rehost 2000 (LR2000), ORCA, CR, MCRS, LLD, and Status data will be "frozen."

This freeze means a copy of these data bases will be archived for data conversion purposes. These data bases may still be accessed after the "freeze" and may continue to be updated until LR2000 is deployed. At deployment the data in LR2000 will contain data up to the "freeze" date. Any actions that have occurred or data updated since the "freeze" date will be manually entered after deployment of LR2000.

PUBLIC NOTICE
NOTICE OF "FREEZING"
ON-LINE RECORDATION AND CASE ACCESS (ORCA),
CASE RECORDATION (CR),
MINING CLAIM RECORDATION SYSTEM (MCRS),
LEGAL LAND DESCRIPTION (LLD), AND STATUS

The Bureau of Land Management is transferring its current legacy systems into a Year 2000 (Y2K) compliant system called Legacy Rehost 2000 (LR2000). The legacy systems include: On-line Recordation and Case Access (ORCA), Case Recordation (CR), Mining Claim Recordation System (MCRS), Legal Land Description (LLD), and Status data bases.

The National Information Resource Management Center (NIRMC) will archive a copy of the data on the above mentioned systems to convert the data into the LR2000 system. The following are the scheduled "freeze" dates for converting the data from the legacy systems and the LR2000 deployment date:

2-22-1999 On-line Recordation Case Access (ORCA)

3-1-1999 Case Recordation and Mining Claim Recordation

3-2-1999 LLD and Status

3-19-1999 Legacy Systems updates discontinued

3-22-1999 Deployment of LR2000

Mid-April Legacy Systems discontinued

The legacy systems will still be available for viewing purposes during the "freeze" up until the systems are discontinued in mid-April.

Updates may be made to these systems after the "freeze" date. These updates include changes and modifications to existing cases or new applications or notices received. Any updates made to the legacy systems after the "freeze" dates will not be in the LR2000 data base at initial deployment, but will be entered soon after deployment. All actions requiring updates, changes, or modifications will be tracked in a suspense file for entry after deployment. The official agency manual records reflecting these actions will still be available for public viewing.
