This IM was originally issued on 6/10/99 and has since expired. It is being reissued now as interim direction until the BLM Sign Manual is completed. The BLM Sign Manual is expected to be completed in the spring of 2004, at which time a Colorado Manual Supplement will issued for the **Travel Management Signs for Public Lands in Colorado**.
