DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED ACTION: The proposal is to offer for lease 14 parcels, totaling approximately 18,709 acres of Federal minerals, for potential oil and gas exploration and production, located in Grand County, Colorado. There are approximately 15,909 acres of BLM owned surface and minerals, 2485 acres of private owned surface with federal minerals and 315 acres of State Land Board owned surface with federal minerals.

Legal descriptions and stipulations are included in Attachment #1.

LAND USE PLAN (LUP) CONFORMANCE REVIEW: The Proposed Action is subject to the following plan:

Name of Plan: Kremmling Resource Management Plan (RMP), Record of Decision (ROD)

Date Approved: December 19, 1984; Updated February 1999

The Proposed Action is in conformance with the LUP because it is specifically provided for in the following LUP decision(s):

Decision Language: "Federal mineral estates will remain open to oil & gas leasing under the Mineral Leasing Act of 1920 except for 1,351 acres which are withdrawn. Some lands are specifically encumbered with surface use restrictions."

1). Is the Proposed Action substantially the same action and at the site specifically analyzed in an existing document?

Yes, the lands involved in this lease offering were analyzed in the *Colorado Oil and Gas Leasing & Development Final EIS Plan Amendment* (Oil and Gas Leasing EIS) and *Kremmling Resource Management Plan Record of Decision*, and a decision was made to make the lands available for lease. The action in this DNA is the same as proposed in that RMP. The RMP decisions were to make Federal oil and gas resources available for leasing with standard stipulations or, where necessary, special stipulations.

According to the Tenth Circuit Court of Appeals, site specific NEPA analysis is not possible absent concrete proposals. Filing of an Application for Permit to Drill is the first useful point at which a site specific environmental appraisal can be undertaken. (Park County Resource Council, Inc. v. U.S. Department of Agriculture, 10th Cir., April 17, 1987). In addition, the Interior Board of Land Appeals has decided that, BLM is not required to undertake a site-specific environmental review prior to issuing an oil and gas lease when it previously analyzed the environmental consequences of leasing the land.... (Colorado Environmental Coalition Et AL., IBLA 96-243, decided June 10, 1999).

2). Was a reasonable range of alternatives to the Proposed Action analyzed in the existing NEPA document(s), and does that range and analysis appropriately consider current environmental concerns, interests, and resource values?

Yes, the alternatives analyzed in the RMP included Continuation of Present Management, Standard Terms and Conditions, and the Proposed Action. They provided a broad range of alternatives which, in our judgment, adequately address current environmental concerns, interests, and resource values.

3). Does the information or circumstances upon which the existing NEPA document(s) are based remain valid and germane to the Proposed Action? Is the analysis still valid in light of new studies or resource assessment information?

There is new information and circumstances in which the existing NEPA documents (i.e. RMP/EIS and Oil and Gas (O&G) Leasing and Development EIS) did not adequately analyze.

The Wolford Mountain Reservoir (WMR) was developed after the 1984 RMP/EIS and 1991 O&G EIS. The four parcels nominated for the current lease sale, #4074, #4075, #4076, and #4077, are located on the west edge of the reservoir. The reservoir was developed for water storage and offers high recreational, fishing, scenic and wildlife values. In addition, the Colorado River Water Conservation District (CRWCD) provided comments to the BLM regarding possible enlargement of the reservoir and hydropower generation. Thus, the BLM is deferring the following parcels #4074, #4075, #4076, and #4077 from the lease sale (see Attachment #1 for legal descriptions).

The BLM recently completed its Wild and Scenic Eligibility Study in accordance with Section 5 (d) 1 of the Wild and Scenic Rivers Act. Rabbit Ears Creek was found to be eligible for geologic Outstanding Remarkable Values (ORVs). River segments determined to be eligible are afforded interim protective management until a suitability study is completed. Parcel #4092 is adjacent to this eligible river segment. Thus, in order to afford adequate protection to the geologic ORV, the BLM is deferring parcel #4092 (see Attachment #1 for legal descriptions).

In addition to the eligibility study, the BLM issued a temporary road closure to motorized travel for the BLM-administered public land within parcel #4092 and #4078, in accordance with title 43, CFR, Section 9268.3(d) (1) Closure of Lands (i) (ii) (iii) (iv) (v), on September 13, 2006. The closure was implemented due to a recent inventory in the area which indicated at least 12 miles of user-created routes that were known to be causing resource damage and providing motorized access into areas where motorized use is strictly prohibited in the Troublesome Wilderness Study Area (WSA). The temporary closure will remain in effect until future travel management designations are made in the area in conjunction with the Kremmling RMP revision. Thus, the BLM is deferring parcel #4092 and the portions of parcel #4078 with BLM-administered surface acres (120 acres).

Based upon a review of new information regarding riparian and wetland values, [CO-28] Controlled Surface Use Stipulation for the protection of perennial water impoundments and streams, and/or riparian/wetland vegetation zones was added to specific parcels. The analysis contained in the Oil and Gas Leasing EIS provided an exception which allowed these stipulations to be added (See Attachment #1 for legal descriptions and stipulations).

4). Does the methodology and analytical approach used in the existing NEPA document(s) continue to be appropriate for the Proposed Action?

Yes, the methodology and analytical approach used in the Kremmling RMP and associated documents are appropriate. The use of new methodologies or approaches would result in the same impact conclusion and leasing decisions.

5). Are the direct and indirect impacts that would result from implementation of the Proposed Action unchanged from those analyzed in the existing NEPA document?

Yes, the direct and indirect impacts of the current proposed action are substantially unchanged from those identified in the Kremmling RMP and associated documents.

(See also 1. above.)

6). Are the cumulative impacts that would result from implementation of the Proposed Action unchanged from those analyzed in the existing NEPA document(s)?

Yes, the cumulative impacts remain the substantially unchanged from those described in the Kremmling RMP and associated documents. Implementing the Proposed Action would not substantially change the cumulative impact analysis.

7). Is the public involvement and interagency review associated with the existing NEPA document(s) adequate for the Proposed Action?

Yes, the Kremmling RMP and associated documents were scrutinized by the public and other agencies. There have been no additional issues or concerns presented in the vicinity of these parcels since 1991 that would warrant reconsideration of leasing decisions for this parcel.

Areas of Critical Environmental Concern: The Cretaceous Ammonite Research Natural Area ACEC is within parcel #4081. This ACEC is 160 acres and was designated for significant marine invertebrate fossils. There is a No Surface Occupancy stipulation (KR-01) that is applied to the entire ACEC to protect the ammonite fossils (see Attachment #1 for legal descriptions and stipulations).

Cultural Resources: Site specific surveys, evaluation and mitigation would be completed prior to the issuance of any permit.

Native American Religious Concerns: Tribal consultation was initiated on April 18, 2007, on the Proposed Action. Additional tribal consultation would occur for site specific consultation prior to the issuance of any permit action.

Threatened, Endangered, and Sensitive Species: *Astragalus osterhoutii* historic habitat is found west of parcel #4076 and #4077. However, both of these parcels are being deferred from the lease sale, so there would be no impacts to this historic habitat.

Visual Resources: The following parcels are managed entirely or in part for Class II Visual Resources. The proposed project areas are located in an area classified as VRM Class II in the KRO 1984 Resource Management Plan. The objective for Class II is to retain the existing character of the landscape. The level of change to the characteristic landscape should be low. Management activities may be seen, but should not attract the attention of the casual observer. Any changes must repeat the basic elements of form, line, color, and texture found in the predominant natural features of the characteristic landscape.

All other parcels are Class III or Class IV areas. The objective of VRM Class III is to partially retain the existing character of the landscape. The level of change in any of the basic landscape elements (line, form, color, texture) due to management activities should be moderate, and not attract the attention of the casual observer.
