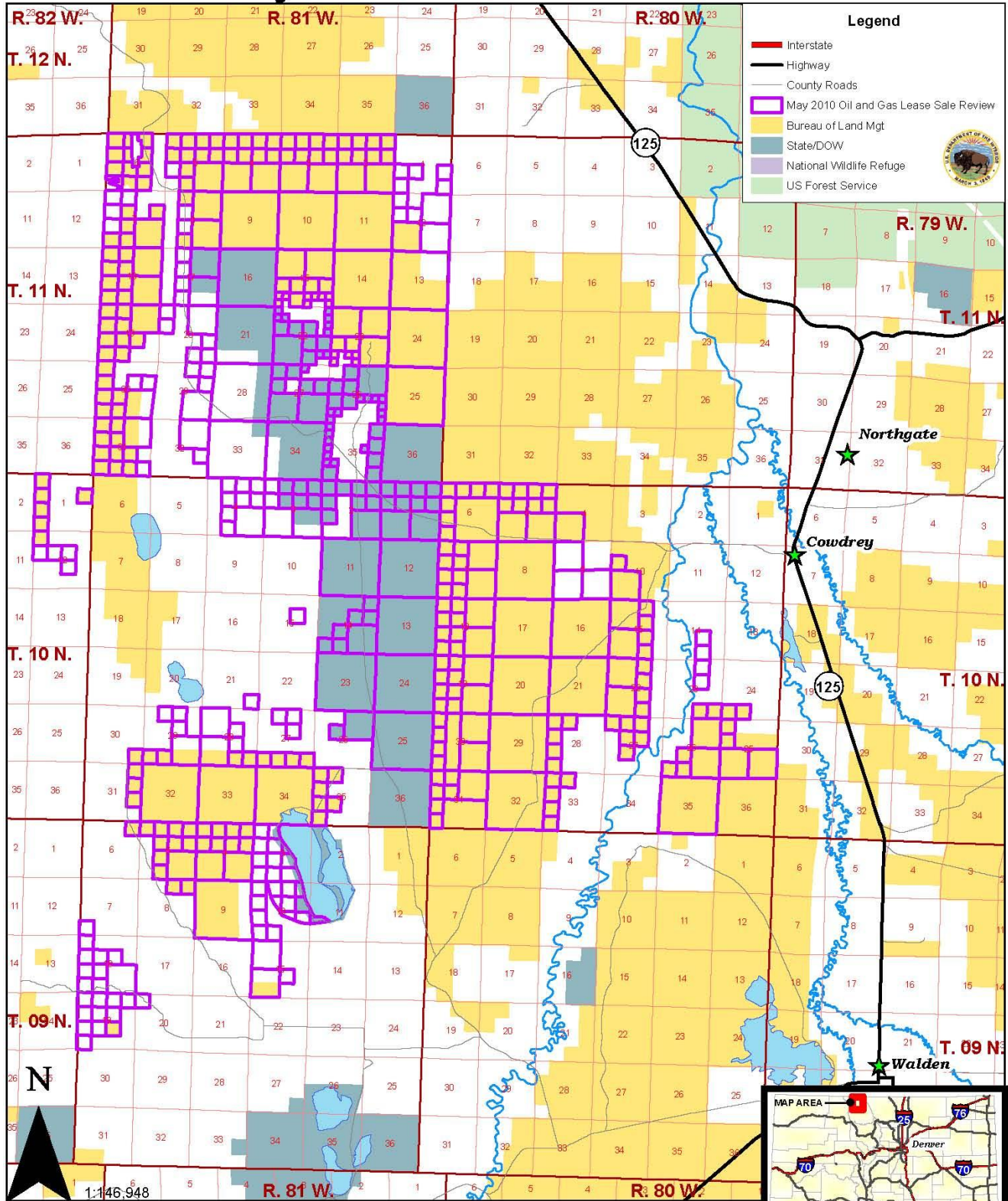

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED ACTION: The proposal is to offer for lease 26 parcels, totaling approximately 45,135 acres of federal minerals, for potential oil and gas exploration and production, located in Jackson County, Colorado. There are approximately 27,535 acres of BLM-owned surface and minerals, 8,337 acres of private owned surface with federal minerals, 129 acres of Colorado Division of Wildlife surface with federal minerals and 9,290 acres of Colorado State Land Board surface with federal minerals.

Attachment A includes legal descriptions of Pre-DNA parcels proposed for lease, totaling 26 parcels with approximately 45,135 acres, Attachment B contains all or portions of 18 deferred parcels with approximately 26,147 acres, and Attachment C contains all or portions of 17 parcels with approximately 18,988 acres available for lease with applied stipulations.

## NEPA Adequacy Criteria

1. *Is the Proposed Action substantially the same action and at the site specifically analyzed in an existing document?*

Yes, the lands involved in this lease offering were analyzed in the *Colorado Oil and Gas Leasing & Development Final EIS Plan Amendment* (Oil and Gas Leasing EIS) and *Kremmling Resource Management Plan*, and decisions were made to make the lands available for lease. The action in this DNA is the same as proposed in the RMP and RMP Amendment. The RMP decisions were to make Federal oil and gas resources available for leasing with standard stipulations or, where necessary, special stipulations.

According to the Tenth Circuit Court of Appeals, site specific NEPA analysis is not possible absent concrete proposals. Filing of an Application for Permit to Drill is the first useful point at which a site specific environmental appraisal can be undertaken. (Park County Resource Council, Inc. v. U.S. Department of Agriculture, 10<sup>th</sup> Cir., April 17, 1987). In addition, the Interior Board of Land Appeals has decided that BLM is not required to undertake a site-specific environmental review prior to issuing an oil and gas lease when it previously analyzed the environmental consequences of leasing the land... (Colorado Environmental Coalition Et AL., IBLA 96-243, decided June 10, 1999).

2. *Was a reasonable range of alternatives to the Proposed Action analyzed in the existing NEPA document(s), and does that range and analysis appropriately consider current environmental concerns, interests, and resource values?*

Yes, the alternatives analyzed in the 1984 RMP and 1991 RMP Amendment included a broad range of alternatives which, in our judgment, adequately address current environmental concerns, interests, and resource values.

3. *Does the information or circumstances upon which the existing NEPA document(s) are based remain valid and germane to the Proposed Action? Is the analysis still valid in light of new studies or resource assessment information?*

Yes, the information or circumstances of the 1984 Kremmling Resource Management Plan and 1991 RMP Amendment remain valid and germane to the Proposed Action. However there has been a change since the Kremmling RMP was signed.

The BLM has begun developing management alternatives to amend the 1984 Kremmling Resource Management Plan (RMP). The management alternatives will analyze impacts to wildlife, including sage-grouse. The BLM is aware of recent information discussing the effectiveness of sage-grouse habitat protection and mitigation measures. The BLM also received recommendations from the Colorado Division of Wildlife (CDOW) regarding sage-grouse habitat protection. As a result, the BLM is deferring portions of specific parcels within sage-grouse habitat (Attachment B). As BLM develops management alternatives, further consultation will be needed with stakeholders and other agencies (i.e. CDOW) to ensure consistency, analyze future management options, and ensure the effectiveness of mitigation measures

Based upon a review of new information regarding riparian and wetland values, Controlled Surface Use Stipulation [CO-28] for the protection of perennial water impoundments and streams, and/or riparian/wetland vegetation zones was added to specific parcels. The analysis contained in the Oil and Gas Leasing EIS provided an exception which allowed these stipulations to be added (see Attachment C).

Since the RMP was approved, on-going scientific research has identified the potential impacts of “greenhouse gases” (GHG) and their effects on global atmospheric conditions. These GHGs include carbon dioxide, CO<sub>2</sub>; methane; nitrous oxide; water vapor; and several trace gases. Through complex interactions on a global scale, these GHG emissions are believed by some to cause a net warming effect of the atmosphere primarily by decreasing the amount of heat energy radiated by the Earth back into space.

In 2001, the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC) predicted that by the year 2100, global average surface temperatures would increase 1.4 to 5.8°C (2.5 to 10.4°F) above 1990 levels. The National Academy of Sciences (2006) supports these predictions, but has acknowledged that there are uncertainties regarding how climate change may affect different regions. In 2007, the IPCC also concluded that “warming of the climate system is unequivocal” and “most of the observed increase in globally average temperatures since the mid-20th century is very likely due to the observed increase in anthropogenic [man-made] greenhouse gas concentrations.” Other theories about the effect of GHG’s on global climate change exist.

The assessment of GHG emissions and climate change remains in its formative phase; therefore, it is not yet possible to know with certainty the net impact to climate from GHGs produced globally over the last century or from those produced today. The lack of scientific tools designed to predict climate change on regional or local scales limits the ability to quantify potential future impacts of climate change on the specific area offered for leasing. In addition, while any leasing and future development may involve some future contribution of GHGs, these contributions would not have a significant effect on a phenomenon occurring at the global scale believed by some to be due to over a century of human activities.

In any case, no emission generating activities can occur without further BLM approval. If the parcels are proposed for development subsequent to lease issuance, operations that may be considered sources of GHG emissions could be made subject to any condition of approval addressing greenhouse gas emissions that BLM may develop through future NEPA analysis at either the plan or development project level designed specifically to reduce GHG emissions. Specific measures developed at the project stage would be incorporated as “Conditions of Approval” in the approved APD and are binding on the operator.

While there is new information concerning the contribution of greenhouse gas emissions to climate change, the information is not significant in relation to the environmental effects of this action. Therefore, no additional NEPA analysis is needed for this action.

4. *Does the methodology and analytical approach used in the existing NEPA document(s) continue to be appropriate for the Proposed Action?*

Yes, the methodology and analytical approach used in the Kremmling RMP and associated documents are appropriate. The use of new methodologies or approaches would result in the same impact conclusion and leasing decisions.

5. *Are the direct and indirect impacts that would result from implementation of the Proposed Action unchanged from those analyzed in the existing NEPA document?*

Yes, the direct and indirect impacts of the current proposed action are substantially unchanged from those identified in the Kremmling RMP and associated documents.

(See also 1. above.)

6. *Are the cumulative impacts that would result from implementation of the Proposed Action unchanged from those analyzed in the existing NEPA document(s)?*

Yes, the cumulative impacts remain substantially unchanged from those described in the Kremmling RMP and associated documents. Implementing the Proposed Action would not substantially change the cumulative impact analysis.

7. *Is the public involvement and interagency review associated with the existing NEPA document(s) adequate for the Proposed Action?*

Yes, the Kremmling RMP and associated documents were scrutinized by the public and other agencies. There have been no additional issues or concerns presented in the vicinity of most parcels since 1991 that would warrant reconsideration of leasing decisions, except those parcels the BLM is deferring.

#### REMARKS:

Cultural Resources: The proposed lease parcels may be found to contain historic properties and/or resources protected under the National Historic Preservation Act (NHPA), American Indian Religious Freedom Act, Native American Graves Protection and Repatriation Act, E. O. 13007, or other statutes and executive orders. The BLM will not approve any ground disturbing activities that may affect any such properties or resources until it completes its obligation under applicable requirements of the NHPA and other authorities. The BLM may require modification to exploration or development proposals to protect such properties, or disapprove any activity that is likely to result in adverse effects that cannot be successfully avoided, minimized or mitigated.

Native American Religious Concerns: Tribal consultation was initiated on January 12, 2010, on the Proposed Action. Additional tribal consultation would occur for site specific consultation prior to the issuance of any permit action.

Paleontology: The proposed lease parcels may contain important fossil resources. An inventory of fossil resources in paleontological areas having a Potential Fossil Yield Category ranking of 4 and 5 would be performed by an accredited paleontologist prior to the issuance of any permit action.

Threatened, Endangered and Sensitive Species: Occupied habitat for the federally endangered plant species *Phacelia formosula* has been deferred for this lease sale (Attachment B - parcel 5641 and 5639). Potential habitat is protected by Exhibit CO-08 and CO-34 for Special Status Plant Species Habitat and the Endangered Species Act respectively. No other threatened or endangered species habitat is known to occur in the areas proposed for leasing and no threatened or endangered species are expected to be impacted by the Proposed Action.

Several parcels are included within Core Sage-grouse habitat and Core Wildlife areas identified by the Colorado Division of Wildlife. As a result BLM is deferring all or portions of specific parcels within these areas. Included for deferral are parcels 5637, 5640, 5641, 5642, 5643, 5644, 5645, 5646, and 5647 and portions of parcels 5658, 5638, 5639, 5634, 5635, 5648, 5652, 5654 and 5659 (Attachment B).

Visual Resources: The visual resource inventory has been updated as part of the resource management plan revision. The inventory did not substantially change in the area of the proposed action. Visual Resource Management class criteria will be applied to any proposed ground-disturbing activities to protect the visual resource inventory.
