

RESOLUTION - FRRAC 02-11

Resolution of the BLM - Front Range Resource Advisory Council regarding the Zapata Falls Campground Fee Establishment

WHEREAS, this is a newly constructed 25-site campground facility;

WHEREAS, no fee has been approved to address costs of operations and maintenance to said facilities;

WHEREAS, fees for sites in this campground cannot be instituted until reviewed and approved through the Recreation Resource Advisory Council (RRAC);

WHEREAS, the RRAC is not able to meet and function at this time;


WHEREAS; fees for sites at this campground cannot be instituted until a Federal Register Notice has been published instituting a 180-day public comment period;


WHEREAS, BLM examination of current fair market value for similar sites and services in this area found standard sites fees are \$11 per night and group site fees is \$20 per night;

THEREFORE, be it resolved the Front Range Resource Advisory Council strongly supports the BLM with establishing the standard campsites fees at \$11 per night and group campsites at \$20 per night.

THEREFORE; be it resolved the Front Range Resource Advisory Council strongly supports the BLM in finding alternative means to collect recreation funds such as public in-kind donations at the campground until the RRAC is able to reconvene and address the establishment of recommended fees.
