

BLM Sensitive Species Review

The 2003 Idaho BLM sensitive species list was reviewed for species occurring in the Burley Field Office area. Habitat was recently surveyed prior to the development of this proposal so only those species occurring in the existing or potential habitat type (sagebrush steppe) were considered further. Data sets including the CDC (July 2008) and Sage Grouse lek database (2007) were explored and observed species were documented in the table below. Furthermore, species occurring in sagebrush steppe were considered even though they may not have previously been observed because the amount of survey effort in the area is not apparent based on the CDC database. Next, the proposed action was reviewed to determine the potential for it to affect any BLM sensitive species observed or expected in the project area and that potential was determined in the potentially affected column of the table below.

Ultimately, species were considered potentially affected because they could use habitat within the project area which may be altered by the proposed action.
