### RATIONALE AND PLAN CONFORMANCE

This proposal is consistent with the 1987 Cascade Resource Management Plan. The following documents adequately consider the proposed action and constitutes BLM's compliance with the requirements of NEPA: (1) DNA Worksheet ID-110-2007-DNA-3605; (2) Normal Fire Emergency Stabilization and Rehabilitation Plan Environmental Assessment, 2005, ID-090-2004-050; (3) Biological Assessment of Normal Fire Emergency Stabilization and Rehabilitation Plan for Boise District Office and Jarbidge Field Office, Twin Falls District, Bureau of Land Management Idaho, 2005; and (4) Noxious and Invasive Weed Treatment for the Boise District and Jarbidge Field Offices Environmental Assessment, 2005, ID-100-2005-EA-265; (5) United States Department of Interior, Bureau of Land Management. My decision will result in the most beneficial, quickest recovery, and least costly stabilization and rehabilitation efforts for the pre-existing vegetation and soil resources of the burned area.
