The Bureau of Land Management, Coeur d'Alene Field Office is planning a series of public workshops regarding its upcoming planning effort for the Blue Creek Bay public lands.

The area, totaling 669 acres along the arm of Wolf Lodge Bay on Lake Coeur d'Alene, was acquired by BLM between 1991 and 2003 through a combination of purchases and donations. The properties were a high priority for public acquisition due to their conservation, historical, and recreational values.

The BLM is now beginning a comprehensive planning process for the area and is requesting public participation throughout the process. The Coeur d'Alene Field Office, in cooperation with the public, will strive to have the management plan completed by the end of 2008.

Three public workshops will be held to inform the public of the planning process and solicit public input regarding the project. Workshops will be held as follows:
