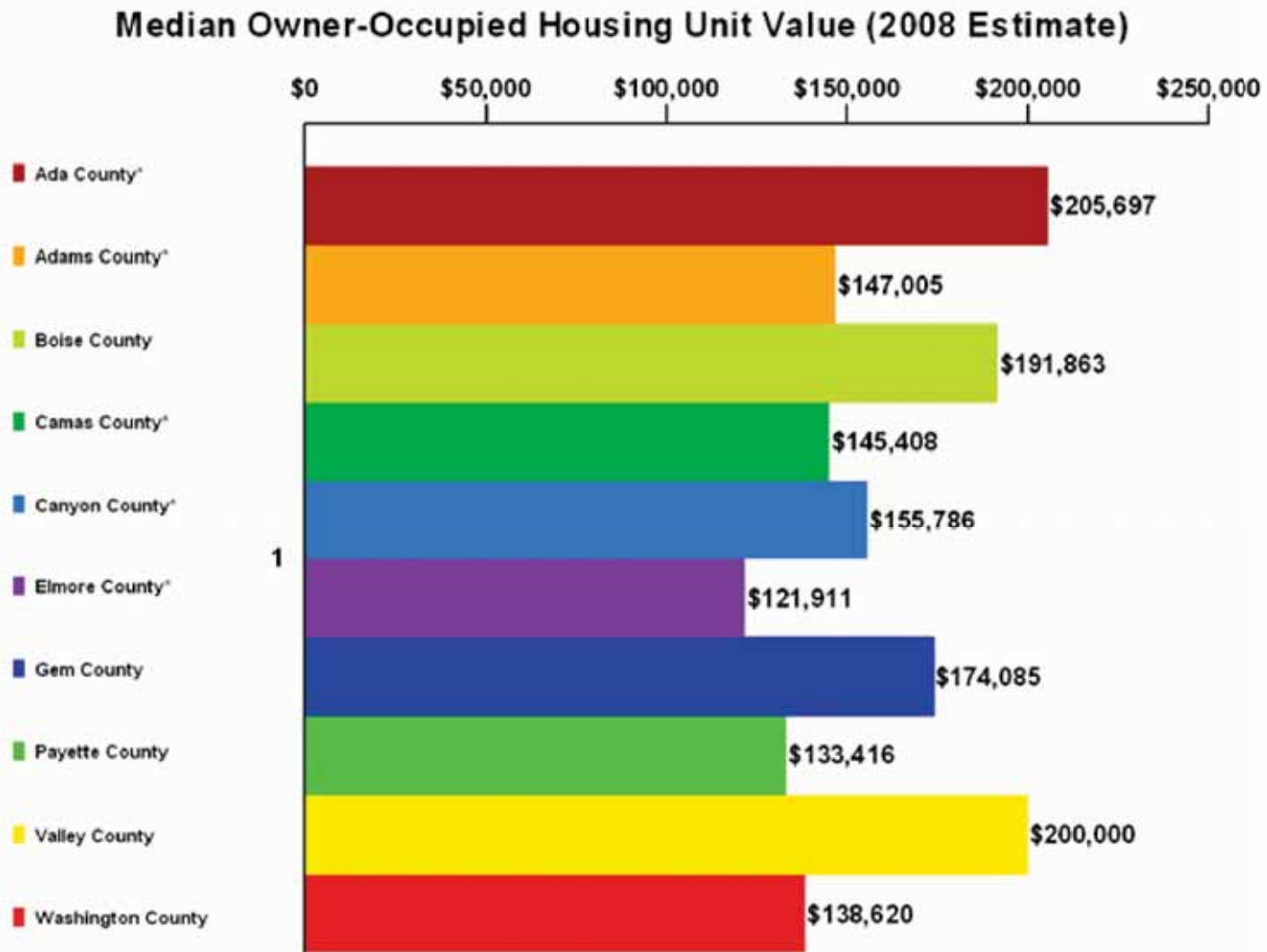


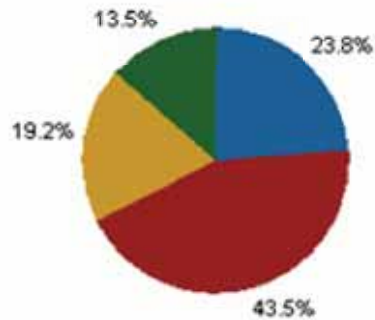
2008 Home Value Comparisons

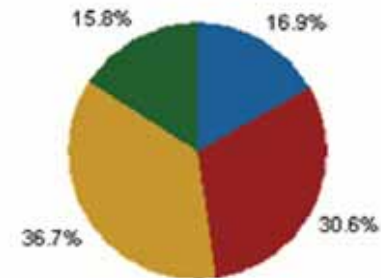
Education Levels Improving

Elmore County, 1980



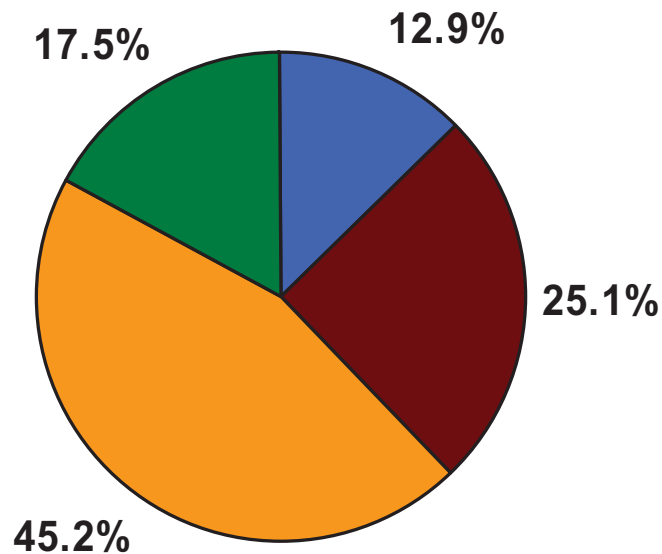

- Bachelor or graduate degree

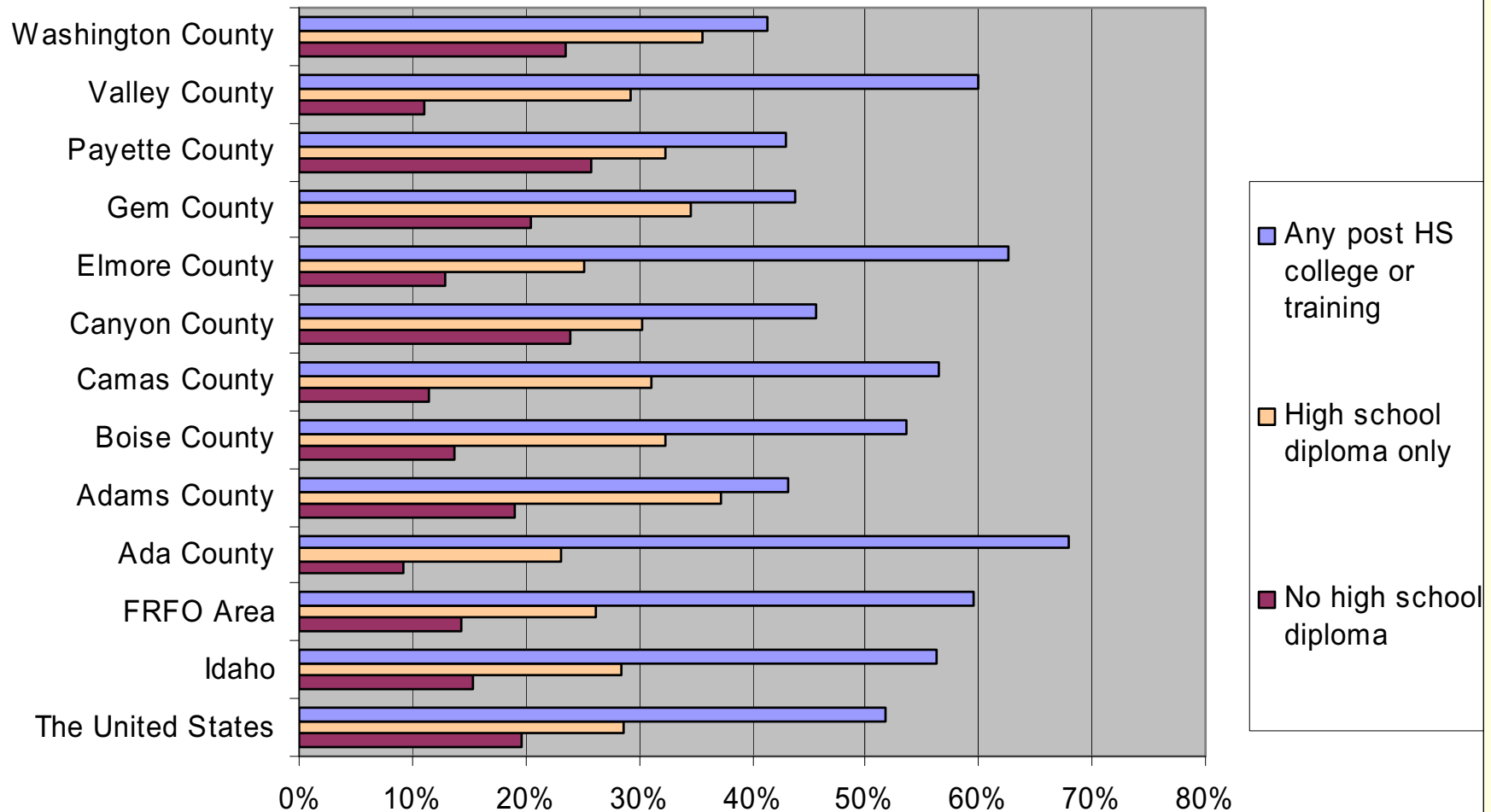
Estimated educational attainment of the population 25 years & older: Elmore County, 2008



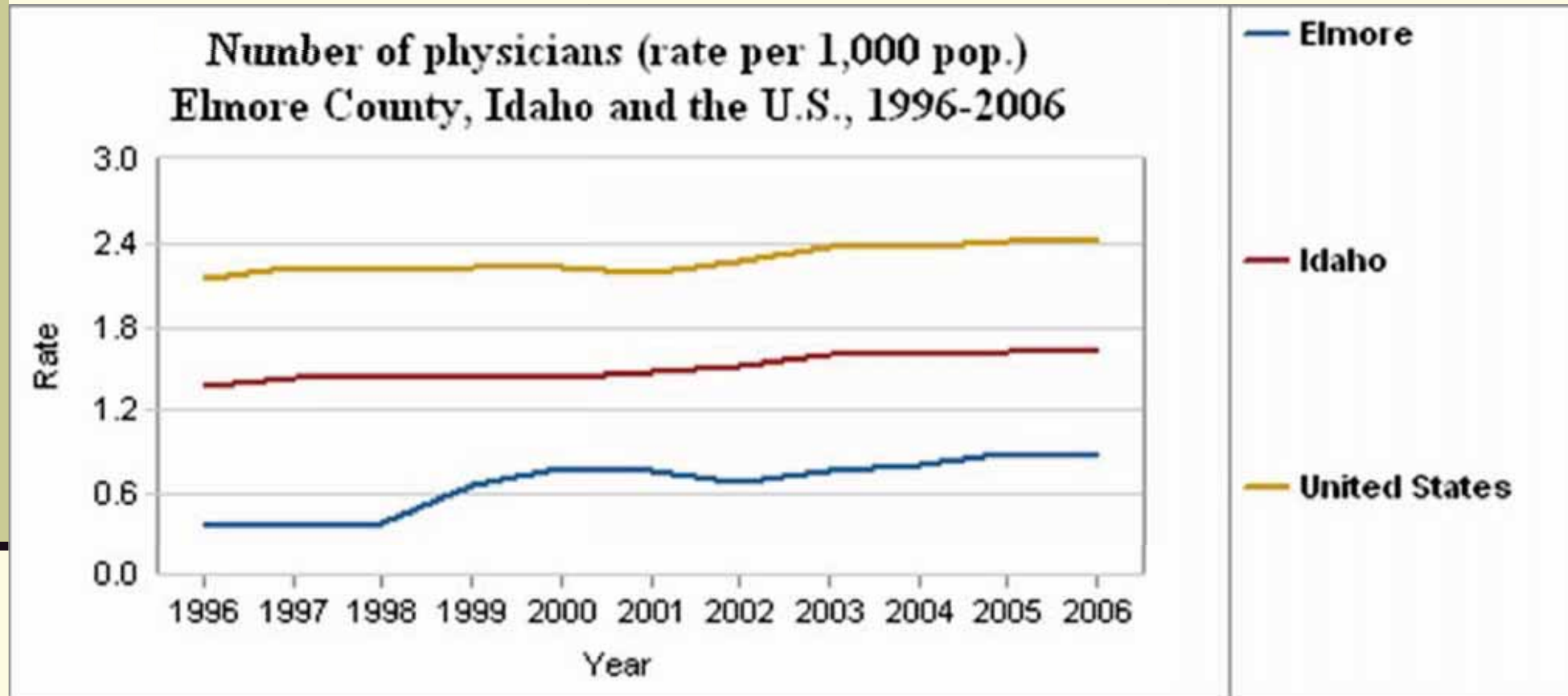

2008 Estimated educational attainment of the population 25 years and older

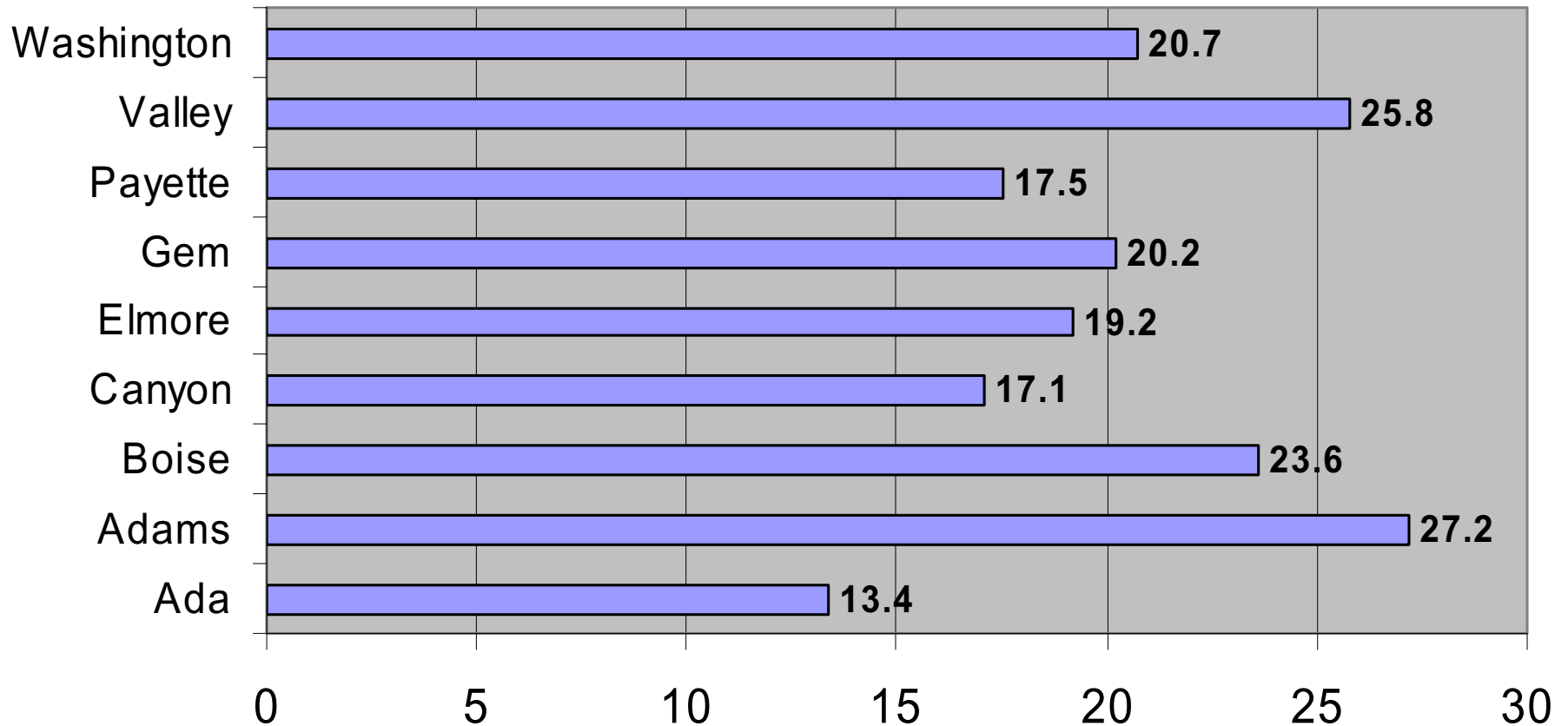


Elmore County Has Much Less Access to Health Care Than Idaho



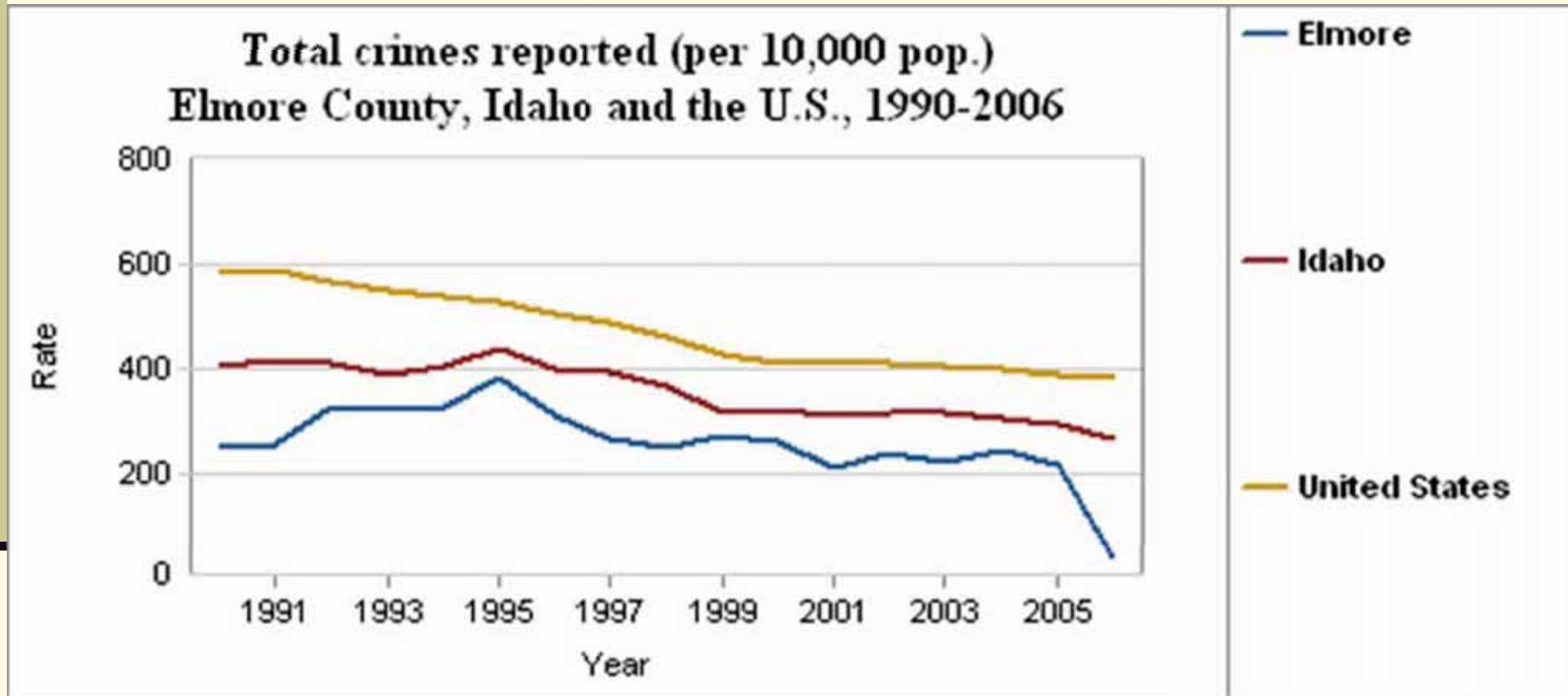
Many Lack Health Insurance

Crime Rates Much Lower than Idaho & U.S. Average



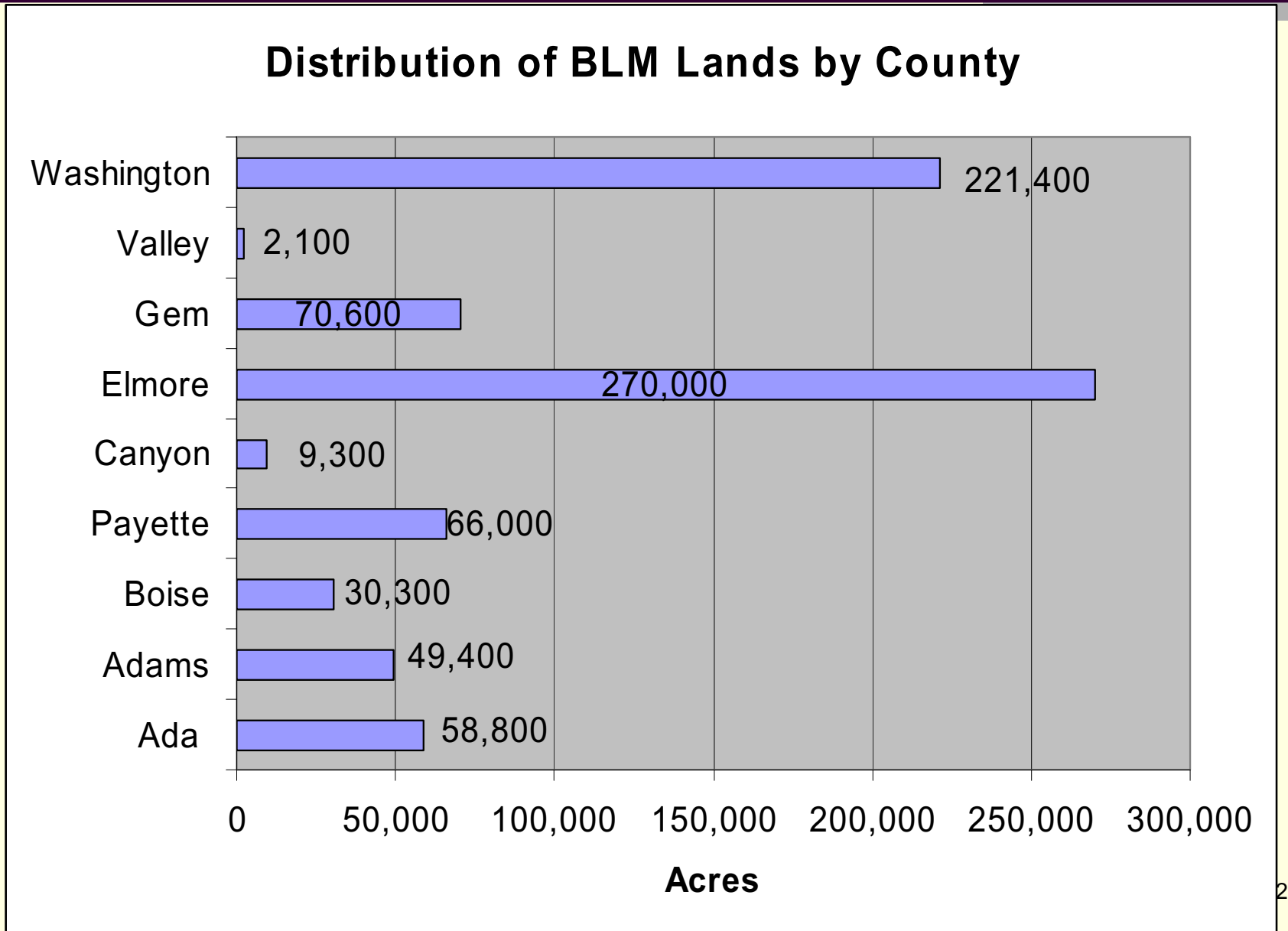
Key Point Summary

1. Population growth was rapid in 1990s, but has grown stagnant this decade.
2. Expect more visitors from a rapidly growing Treasure Valley.
3. The Hispanic community is growing.
4. Traditional resource industries are probably not engines of future growth.
5. Rise in self-employment signals the importance of entrepreneurs.
6. Non-labor income has grown as a share of the county economy, but is less than most counties.
7. High traffic counts on I-84 create potential for pass-through visitor services.
8. Elmore County incomes are somewhat low, especially in Glens Ferry.
9. There is likely high retail leakage out of the western portion of Elmore County.

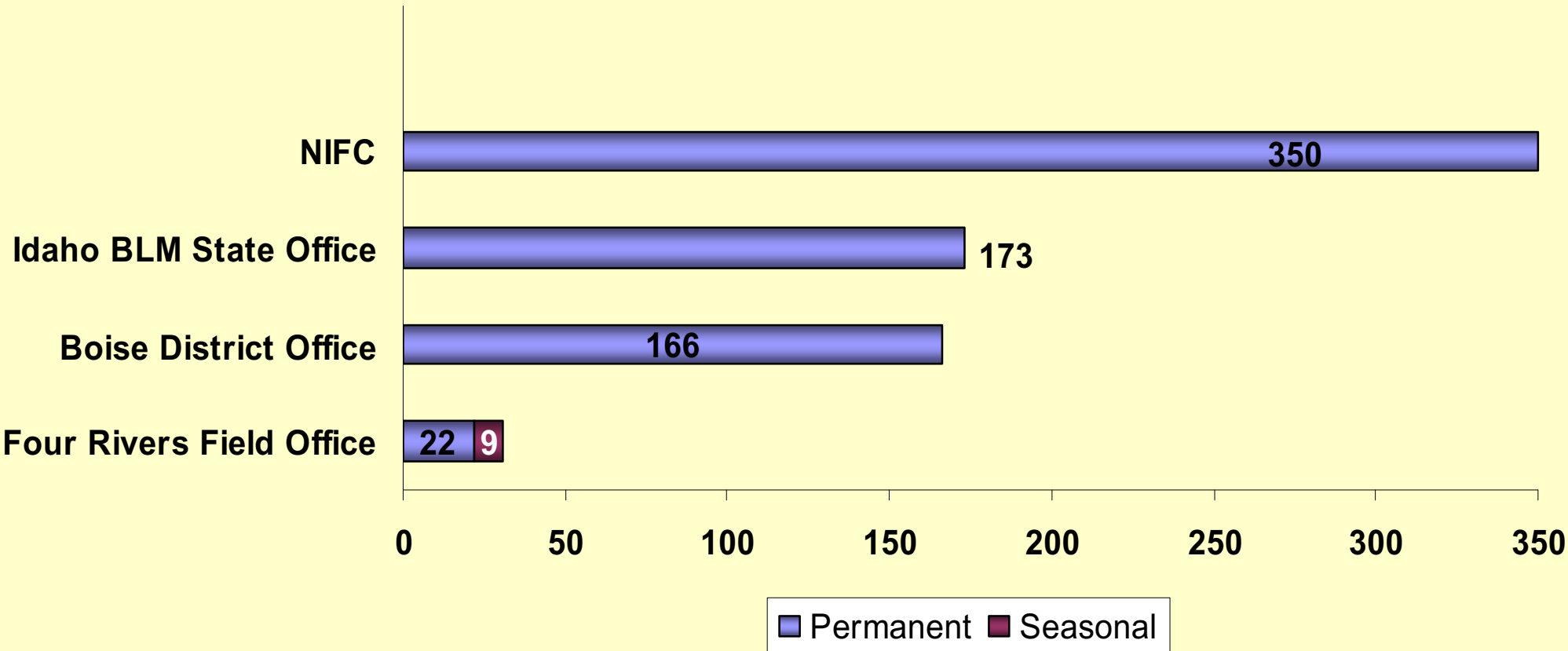


How Much BLM Land?

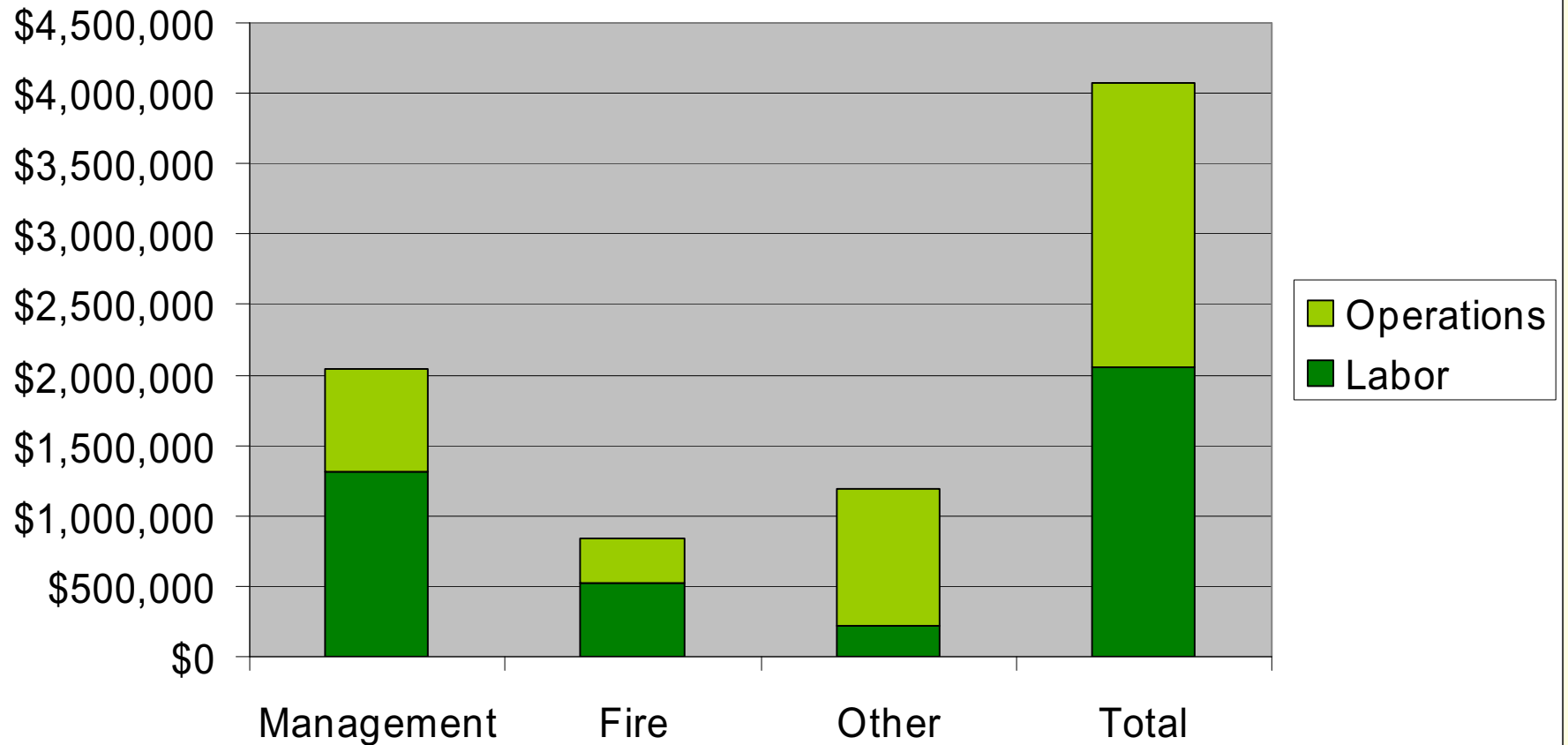
BLM Employment in FRFO
