

**The Weather:** The city Burley is located in the Snake River Plain, where the topography and altitude have given the area a moderate four-season climate. Summers are dry, with very little precipitation, and the average July temperatures range in the mid to high 80s. Winters receive snowfall and can be windy, but rarely become uncomfortably cold.

**Recreation:** The City of Rocks: Established in 1988, the 14,000-acre park is a fragile environment with scenic, geological and historical significance. More recently it has gained national renown for the outstanding rock climbing it provides. Most of the more than 600 routes are located on 100 to 300 foot spires and range from 5.4 to 5.14a in difficulty. Camping, hiking, mountain biking and picnicking are also available. During the winter, the reserve is a beautiful place for a cross-county skiing adventure.

Lake Cleveland: Crystal clear water awaits you at Lake Cleveland, a crater lake tucked beneath the summit of Mt. Harrison. During the summer months, there is excellent hiking and fishing in the area and the wildflowers are abundant.

Many Burley residents make a living in the retail and service industry as well.

Burley is the second largest city in south-central Idaho and is located on the plains near the Snake River. It is renowned for its access to recreation spots like The City of Rocks, Pommerelle Ski Resort and mountain areas such as Lake Cleveland. The area is home to the Oregon and California Trails, along with more than thirty other pioneer trails.
