

Map shows the existing and proposed Area of Critical Environmental Concern (ACEC) Designations under Alternative C. Sleeping Giant ACEC (11,679 acres) is the only existing ACEC under Alternative A and would be carried forward under all alternatives. Additional potential ACECs proposed under Alternative C would be: Elkhorns (67,665 acres), Humbug Spires (8,374 acres), Spokane Creek (14 acres), and Ringing Rocks (160 acres).

With the exception of the Elkhorn Mountains ACEC, the boundaries of all other ACECs, where proposed under other RMP alternatives, match the boundaries shown on this map.

All proposed ACEC acres in other RMP alternatives are a subset of the areas identified under Alternative C, with the exception of the inclusion of the Iron Mask acquisition lands within the proposed Elkhorn Mountains ACEC under Alternative B shown on Map 33.
