General Rules include:

- No smoking in or around buildings, corrals, fields, hay storage, trails or wild lands.
- No sale of alcohol or other controlled substances may occur on the premises.
- Children and pets shall be supervised by an adult at all times when occupying the premises. Be especially watchful around irrigation canals, bridges, livestock pens, agricultural machinery, historic buildings and vegetation (trees, brush) areas.
- Watch for and avoid: rattlesnakes, gopher snakes, rodents, varmints, and insects.
- Horses fed on-site shall be provided certified weed-free or locally grown hay; or pelleted feeds. Unconsumed feed or bedding must be collected and removed.
- Horse manure deposited in a parking or public use area shall be collected and disposed of appropriately.
- Observe and Preserve:
 - Natural resources and wildlife
 - Historic and pre-historic archaeological features and artifacts.
- Learn and practice public land stewardship and land use ethics:
 - Tread Lightly! (www.treadlightly.org)
 - Leave No Trace (www.lnt.org)
- In case of Emergency: dial 911 (accident, injury, fire or public safety issue)

Summary of Supplementary Rules Applicable to the Silver Saddle Ranch (SRS)
(See Federal Register Vol. 65, No. 224 Nov 20, 2000 Page 69783 for entire publication):

1. SRS is Day Use only; open Sunrise to Sunset, unless otherwise posted or permitted.
2. Unless otherwise permitted, access shall be via the public gate off Carson River Rd.
3. Motor vehicle use restricted to parking areas and designated routes.
4. Motorized vehicles must be equipped with an approved spark arrester.
5. Horse and bicycle use on roads and designated trails
6. Dogs must be leashed at all times
7. Pet waste must be collected, removed and disposed of appropriately.
8. Cooking while picnicking may occur using portable stove using gas, kerosene, jellied petroleum, or pressurized liquid fuel.
 - Charcoal may be used by permit only.
9. Prohibited acts include:
 - Discharge of firearms, fireworks or projectiles
 - Starting or using a campfire outside of a designated fire ring
10. Closed to public use unless guided or otherwise permitted use:
 - A ¾ mile long riparian area on the western bank of the Carson River.
 - All agricultural fields while farming/grazing in active use.
