Dear Reader:

On 14 February 2008 this office issued a document titled "Multiple Use Decision- Hubbard Vineyard Allotment." Due to a request by BLM, on 20 October 2008 this decision was vacated and remanded back to the agency for further action.

The BLM has revised and is re-releasing the Hubbard Vineyard Allotment Evaluation. The evaluation displays all available monitoring data on the allotment and makes draft determinations on the level of attainment of allotment specific multiple use objectives and the Standards and Guidelines for Rangeland Health. The evaluation will be available for review on the internet at the Elko District's website ([http://www.blm.gov/nv/st/en/fo/elko\\_field\\_office.html](http://www.blm.gov/nv/st/en/fo/elko_field_office.html)). Copies of the document are also available from the Elko District Office on request.

The BLM is seeking input from the permittee, affected agencies, and members of the public interested in livestock grazing management on the Hubbard Vineyard Allotment in developing management strategies and alternatives that are in conformance with the Wells Resource Management Plan and that will make significant progress towards attaining the Standards and Guidelines for Rangeland Health. All comments must be received by the Elko Field Office by close of business on Friday, 31 July 2009. Comments received through this scoping process will be used to develop alternatives to be considered in the preparation of a new environmental analysis and disclosure of impacts to be prepared for compliance with the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA). The process will result in BLM issuing a new multiple use decision for the Hubbard Vineyard Allotment.
