BLM FOREST PRODUCTS FOR SALE
(Advertisement & Short Form Bid)

Sealed bids will be accepted by the District Forestry Lead at the Ely BLM District Office, 702 North Industrial Way, HC33 Box 33500, Ely, Nevada 89301 up to, but not later than, the oral auction time of each unit that a written bid is submitted. Oral auction will begin at **9:00 a.m. Pacific Time on August 4, 2006**, for all pine nut units.

A separate certified check, bank draft, cashiers check, or money order in the amount of \$300 payable to the Bureau of Land Management, USDI must accompany the bid for each sale area, as a security deposit to be applied to the purchase price, refunded or retained for application toward payment of damages. Sale areas with a closing bid of over 50,000 pounds requires a ten (10) percent security deposit due at close of auction for that sale area. For bidders participating in the oral auction, the \$300 security deposit will be immediately refunded to all unsuccessful bidders at the close of auction for each unit. This security deposit may be applied to any unit remaining to be auctioned. **PERSONAL CHECKS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**

Additional information on the product, condition of sale, and bidding may be obtained at any of the Nevada BLM offices, or the Utah BLM Cedar City Office before bids are submitted.

If you are awarded a sale you must agree to the following:

- a. To execute a product sale contract and deposit total bid price in person at the appropriate BLM Office within 21 days from receipt of notice of acceptance of bid. (For sales of \$500 or more, the authorized officer may allow payment by installments as provided by 43 CFR 5461.2).
- b. That upon failure to execute a contract, within the allotted time period, the sale may be closed without recourse, and the security deposit may be retained toward liquidation of damages.
- c. To harvest the product included in this sale under the provisions and requirements of the "Contract for the Cash Sale of Vegetative Resources" to be issued to me in response to my bid and the award of sale.
- d. To allow the public to harvest pinion nuts for personal use from within the sale area.
- e. To deposit a performance bond in the amount of \$300 or 20% of the total contract value whichever is greater. The performance bond shall be forfeited to the amount of damages as determined by the authorized officer if all contract provisions are not faithfully and fully performed by the purchaser.

Indicate in the "Bid Price" column, your bid for the sale area. Indicate in the "Number of Pounds Bid" column, the number of pounds upon which the "Bid Price" is based. **Award of the contract will be made to that responsible bidder whose bid is most advantageous on the basis of the total return to the United States.** The Government may, when in its interest, reject any or all bids or waive any informality in bids received. No guarantee is made of the estimated number of pounds or quality as stated.
