

## **Trails Master Plan Purpose and Need**

The Sloan Canyon NCA trail system is intended to be a complete trail system for nonmotorized use that connects to the City of Henderson's Open Space and Trails system including the approved Anthem Trails System, and the proposed McCullough Hills Trail. It is intended to meet the needs of hikers, equestrians, and mountain bikers by providing a range of opportunities for differing skill levels and abilities. As stated in the Sloan Canyon RMP, motorized uses are not allowed within the NCA other than on designated roadways, and therefore will not be considered during this process.

The purpose of the Trails Master Plan project is to provide outdoor recreational opportunities in Sloan Canyon NCA consistent with the September 2005 Resource Management Plan. This can be accomplished through a variety of possible measures, which could include the use of existing user-created routes, the construction of new trails, and/or the designation of current inventoried routes.

The Master Plan also provides for the restoration of non-designated roads and trails located in sensitive settings.
