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Second Affordable Housing Project Proposed Under Southern Nevada Public Land Management Act

Las Vegas – The Bureau of Land Management published a notice of realty action in today's *Federal Register* to propose the sale of a 10-acre parcel of public land for affordable housing. BLM is seeking public comment on the proposal for multi-family rental housing at the property located in the southwest Las Vegas Valley at Arby Avenue and Riley Street.

A 45-day public comment period begins with the publication of the notice in the *Federal Register* and ends September 20, 2007. Written comments are to be addressed to the Field Manager, Las Vegas Field Office, Bureau of Land Management, 4701 N. Torrey Pines Drive, Las Vegas, NV 89130.

This is the second affordable housing property to be conveyed under Section 7(b) of the Southern Nevada Public Land Management Act in the Las Vegas Valley. The Act makes it possible for government agencies to buy federal land for affordable housing for up to a 95 percent discount. The affordable housing parcel will be offered to Clark County at less than fair market value.
