

Proposal to Lease

One parcel totaling approximately 228.04 acres of public lands generally available for geothermal leasing under Bureau of Land Management (BLM) land use plans were considered for the geothermal lease sale scheduled to be held on July 14, 2009.

Based on recommendations from the Cedar City BLM Field Office, I am proposing to offer one parcel totaling 228.04 acres of BLM administered lands with appropriate conditions and stipulations.

The lands to be offered are identified by a serial number on the attached list which identifies the specific conditions, terms, stipulations and notices applicable to each parcel.

The parcel has been reviewed to determine if existing planning and NEPA documents adequately address the issues and environmental consequences of leasing at this time. My proposal to offer the parcel in the Cedar City Field Office is based on the findings and recommendations made in the Cedar City Field Office Determination of NEPA Adequacy (DNA), as modified by recommendations made by the Utah State Office Energy Support Team.
