Subject: December 2008 Competitive Oil and Gas Lease Sale DNA

The Moab Field Office reviewed 72 parcels for the December 2008 competitive oil and gas lease sale. All 72 parcels were reviewed for land use plan conformance and NEPA adequacy as documented through completion of a Documentation of Land Use Plan Conformance and NEPA Adequacy (DNA) Worksheet attached to this Memorandum. During this review one parcel was identified as being closed to leasing. A total of 71 parcels are recommended for lease sale. Following is a summary of the determinations and recommendations:

The signed CONCLUSION at the end of this worksheet is part of an interim step in the BLM's internal analysis process and does not constitute an appealable decision; however, it constitutes an administrative record to be provided as evidence in protest, appeals and legal procedures.

A. BLM Office: Moab Field Office (UT-060)

Proposed Action Title/Type: December 2008 competitive Oil and Gas Lease Sale

Location of Proposed Action: Parcels within Grand County and San Juan County, Utah.
Attachment 2 contains legal descriptions for each parcel

Description of the Proposed Action: The Utah State Office proposes to offer 70 parcels of land in Grand and San Juan Counties, Utah administered by the Moab Field Office for oil and gas leasing in a competitive lease sale to be held on December 19, 2008. All 70 parcels were assessed for land use plan compliance and NEPA adequacy. Sixty-two (62) parcels are located in Grand County, Utah and eight (8) parcels are located in San Juan County, Utah. *Attachment 2* lists all parcels including special lease stipulations. These parcels include public lands or lands in which the mineral estate is administered by the BLM. If a parcel of land is not purchased at the lease sale by competitive bidding, it may still be leased within two years after the initial offering under a current review of NEPA adequacy. A lease may be held for ten years, after which the lease expires unless oil or gas is produced in paying quantities. A producing lease can be held indefinitely by economic production.

Planning decisions place certain lands in a no leasing category. Most lands are leased with minor stipulations attached to the lease from the appropriate land use plan for the area. Some lands are leased with limited areas of no surface occupancy within the lease boundaries. Some lands are leased with no stipulations other than those found on the standard lease contract form. A lease grants the right to drill for oil and gas, at some location on the lease.

A lessee must submit an Application for Permit to Drill (APD) (Form 3160-3) to the BLM for approval and must possess an approved APD prior to any surface disturbance in preparation for drilling. Any stipulations attached to the standard lease form must be complied before an APD may be approved. Following BLM approval of an APD, a lessee may produce oil and gas from the well in a manner approved by BLM in the APD or in subsequent sundry notices. The operator must notify the appropriate authorized officer, 48 hours before starting any surface disturbing activity approved in the APD.

B. Conformance with the Land Use Plan (LUP) and Consistency with Related Subordinate Implementation Plans

- Moab Field Office Resource Management Plan, October 31, 2008

The proposed action is in conformance with the applicable LUP because it is specifically provided for in the following LUP decisions:

“MIN-19 - Leasable Minerals: Oil and Gas Leasing Categories (Map 12):

- *Approximately 427,273 acres will be open to oil and gas leasing, subject to standard terms and conditions.*
- *Approximately 806,994 acres will be open to oil and gas leasing subject to conditional surface use (CSU) and timing limitations (TL) stipulations.*
- *Approximately 217,480 acres will be open to oil and gas leasing subject a no surface occupancy (NSO) stipulation.*
- *Approximately 370,250 acres will be closed to oil and gas leasing, of which 25,306 acres were outside Wilderness or Wilderness Study Areas. About 25306 acres are closed to leasing because it is no reasonable to apply a no surface occupancy (NSO) stipulation. This includes areas where the oil and gas resources are physically inaccessible by current directional drilling technology from outside the boundaries of the NSO areas. (These lands closed to oil and gas leasing will be managed to preclude all other surface disturbing activities.) Should technology change, a Plan Amendment will be initiated to place these 25, 306 acres under an NSO stipulation for oil and gas leasing.”*

Documentation of answer and explanation:

The Moab Proposed Resource Management Plan Final Environmental Impact Statement (RMP EIS) analyzed leasing in detail through comparison of four alternatives. During the analysis, the BLM identified land-use plan leasing allocations for all lands within the Moab Field Office. Lease stipulations were developed in this document to mitigate the impacts of oil and gas activity once the rights of the lessee to the lease are exercised (refer to page 2-15 of this document).

2. Is the range of alternatives analyzed in the existing NEPA document(s) appropriate with respect to the current proposed action, given current environmental concerns, interests, resource values, and circumstances?

Documentation of answer and explanation:

Four different alternatives that included a “No Action” alternative were analyzed in the RMP EIS. The range was broad enough to analyze oil and gas leasing through the application of stipulations to varying degrees of acreage where they would apply. Each alternative identified land-use plan leasing allocations and the stipulations that would be applied to those lands throughout the Moab Field Office.

3. Is existing analysis adequate in light of any new information or circumstances (including, for example, riparian proper functioning condition [PFC] reports; rangeland health standards assessments; Unified Watershed Assessment categorizations; inventory and monitoring data; most recent Fish and Wildlife Service lists of threatened, endangered, proposed, and candidate species; most recent BLM lists of sensitive species)? Can you reasonably conclude that all new information and all new circumstances are insignificant with regard to analysis of the proposed action?

Documentation of answer and explanation:

The RMP EIS used and analyzed new information taken from a variety of sources as documented in the EIS administrative record. New information was especially used in analysis of the following areas: areas of critical environmental concern, wild and scenic rivers, SRMAs, environmental justice, riparian areas, sensitive soils, steep slopes, white-tailed prairie dog habitat, Gunnison prairie dog habitat, and other special status species, sage grouse breeding and leks, big horn sheep habitat and lambing, deer and elk winter range, antelope fawning areas, kit fox, visual resources, ACECs, invasive, noxious weeds, and wilderness character. This new information supports the application of the stipulations applied to the parcels in this lease sale.

Native American Religious Concerns: Native American consultations were completed throughout the RMP planning process. In addition, Native American consultation with Tribes will be completed prior to the December lease sale.

Cultural Resources: The area of potential effect for this undertaking is generally the entire lease parcels as defined Attachment 2.

These leases may be found to contain historic properties and/or resources protected under the National Historic Preservation Act (NHPA), American Indian Religious Freedom Act, Native American Graves Protection and Repatriation Act, E.O. 13007, or other statues and executive orders. The BLM will not approve any ground disturbing activities that may affect any such properties or resources until it completes its obligations under applicable requirements of the

NHPA and other authorities. The BLM will require class III cultural resource inventories to be completed prior to granting approval for ground disturbing activities. The BLM may require modification to exploration, or development proposals to protect such properties, or disapprove any activity that is likely to result in adverse effects that cannot be successfully avoided, minimized or mitigated.

The Moab Field Office has concurrence State Historic Preservation Office that we do not consult them at the leasing stage.

4. Do the methodology and analytical approach used in the existing NEPA documents(s) continue to be appropriate for the current proposed action?

Documentation of answer and explanation:

The methodology and approach used in the Moab RMP Final EIS are appropriate for the current proposed action because the methods of extraction, land requirements for exploration and development, and potential impacts have not changed substantially since completion of these documents. The basic analysis assumptions included in these documents are applicable to the current proposal.

Documentation of answer and explanation:

The Moab RMP Final EIS evaluated the direct and indirect impacts of oil and gas leasing per the leasing categories; whether open to leasing, open to leasing with special stipulations or otherwise. As identified under criterion 3, no significant new information or circumstances have been identified which would render the existing analyses inadequate for leasing the above parcels. Nor have the existing resource conditions and other elements of the human environment changed substantially from those evaluated in the existing documents.

6. Are the reasonably foreseeable cumulative impacts that would result from implementation of the proposed action remain substantially unchanged from those identified in the existing NEPA document(s)?

As part of the RMP EIS analysis a reasonable foreseeable development (RFD) for oil and gas was developed. This RFD was used to analyze cumulative impacts. The potential cumulative impacts are unchanged from those analyzed in the RMP EIS and the RFD.

Documentation of answer and explanation:

The public involvement and interagency review procedures and findings made through the development of the Moab RMP approved October 31, 2008 are adequate for the proposed lease sale. Public meetings were held for scoping for the RMP EIS, and after the draft RMP EIS comment period was over. A Federal Register Notice concerning the preparation and availability of the Proposed Plan and Final EIS was posted on August 1, 2008. A series of opportunities, through comment periods, public workshops, and similar meetings, ensured an appropriate level of public participation during the preparation of the RMP EIS between 2003 and 2008.


