Paul Lothar at NPS is working with NCSHPO to put together a task force. Some of the effort will be a server.

If the funding is passed, then NPS would consume about 1 million of 5 million total funding. The other funds would be available to the states or some other uses. At the moment, there is no money actually available. Currently, planning teleconferences are being held, and the composition of the team is under discussion. The grant panel, etc., are all under discussion.
