1 Logan Norris of Oregon State University published his findings of stream contamination in the Journal of Forestry in 1971, stating "some herbicides were found in all streams near treated areas." He cited cases of up to 840 parts per billion (ppb) of 2,4-D.

2 In 1977 the Coos Bay BLM later published their findings that in a model spray operation of theirs "streams were contaminated 70% of the time."
