Meeting began 5:06 pm, Minutes of the April 28, 2005 meeting were approved.

Clint gave us a summary of the PAWG meeting held the week of May 16, 2005. The Historical and Cultural Task Group was approved money for public education, monitoring sites and for soil studies.

Soil Studies will use a large portion of the monies allotted for our group. This project could be on going and maybe last four seasons. \$50,000 has been allotted for fieldwork this year and \$100,000 for next year. This could increase thru matching funds from outside sources. For the \$100,000 to get committed things need to happen quickly. Kierson thanked Dennis for arranging the meeting with NRCS & PAWG (H & C Task Group). The task group will keep in touch with Mr. Schultz, Nick and Jane of NRCS to get some of the \$100,000 for soil studies.

Monitoring the Lander Trail with 360 degree video needs to be completed by end of Sept, 05 Kierson has been in contact with the professional who did the sample video and he will be able to come out by the end of June to get the first phase of this plan put in place. \$15,000 has been allotted for the monitoring plan. The first phase should be on line by fall. Clint and Dave thanked Kierson for all his help getting Sam, the professional who does the video, to come out to do this.

Public Education will take on the form of a new brochure. There is about \$2,000 allotted for the development of this item. It needs to be ready to be printed by the end of Sept. 05

Another \$2,000 is allotted for the monitoring part of the program and the end of the year summaries.

Sample monitoring forms were review and it was decided to use the forms on our monitoring day to determine what features we like best about each one. Site monitoring other than Lander Trail will start in June with BLM representatives and volunteers. We will meet 9am on June 10 at the Pinedale BLM office to survey the area and determine who can review what sites.

We still need to address signage and costs. An upright sign can cost \$1,200 to \$1,500 and a low profile sign can cost \$600 to \$1,000. Funding could come from a variety of sources, perhaps an organization or community project would help.

We will review the teacher packet that Dave has from the state BLM about archeology. We need to put

together a packet and see what we want to do with it. The lesson plans we have are geared for middle school. Some other ideas are to maybe schedule a teacher's conference as a informational project giving them ideas to use in classrooms and on field trips or help in establishing a after school history club.

There is a meeting in Park City Sept 15-18 that should be of local interest and should be advertised in the local paper.

Participation in our group should be encouraged to be attended by SHPO. Dave will email Claudia about our meetings and if she cannot attend perhaps the main PAWG will have suggestions as to who from SHPO can attend.

- Recap :
1. Dave and Kierson to check on \$100,000 as to how they are going to distribute it.
 2. Kierson will take care of follow up on the video of the Lander Trail.
 3. Monitoring of sites preliminary exploration will be June 10.
 4. Public education brochure will be worked on by Dave. We have \$2,000 budgeted for this project.
 5. Database analysis and professional archeological excavations will be discussed further at our next meeting in the fall . Dave and Kierson will be attending a Archeological meeting and they will try to advertise our projects at that meeting.
 6. Artifact collecting signage and formation will be put up during the summer months.
