- Review of 3-14-06 meeting minutes. Kevin has not submitted 3-28-06 minutes.
- Charles presented results of 4-20-06 PAWG meeting.
- Tom Curry was accepted as a member of the Pinedale Anticline Transportation Task Group.
- Bill discussed current status of mapping roads and pipelines on the Anticline.
- Bill stated that installation of road identification and speed limit signs was complete.
- Discussion of the status of radar system. Bill stated that additional software was needed from the manufacture.
- Butch said that the county has been taking traffic counts @ Paradise Road and that the information is available. Betty asked where and if all traffic count information was being compiled. Charles stated that WYDOT would be the optimum site for this information to reside, all members agreed.
- Betty stated that dust abatement was a big concern at a recent state meeting. Group then discussed mag-water and other types of road treatments to reduce dust.
- Conversation pertaining to the effectiveness of fluid gathering systems vs. trucking of fluids.
- Bill presented a map of a possible access route to the North end of the Anticline that would bypass the town of Pinedale.
- Charles opened up discussion about the future of the task group and stated that he wished to resign his chairman position.
- Wild life sign on at North end of East Green River Road is a safety issue. Charles will send a letter to BLM stating that is should be placed in an alternate location
- Tyler Street access should be considered as a high priority item for the PAWG to consider.
