1. Clint not enough time to formally revised recommendation update before PAWG meeting but individuals could make their own recommendations to PAWG before meeting .

2. Main focus is to revise our monitoring plan .

3. PAWG trying to get more members on their board .

4. From PAWG meeting our focus needs to stay on Anticline Cultural & Historical recommendations .

5. Chuck Otto (BLM/PFO) stated that the Anticline has a ripple effect on other concerns and one thing we need to consider is projects adjacent to Anticline & recommend comments on them .

6. States Preservation booklet is out of which we got a copy for OCTA .

7. Sam Drucker ( BLM/PFO ) reported on Wardell Buffalo Trap project from summer of 2007 they got 3/4 ton approximately of buffalo bones , 30 projectile points from wash .. JIO funded \$40,000.00 for this project to preserve significant archeological site . Site was put in as a National Historical Site . Another \$30,000.00 from Ultra was given to do a bone analysis by Western Wyoming College .Final stabilization work was done and completed fall of 2007 .

8. Dave Vlcek said there might be \$10,000.00 for Boulder Project .

9. Clint brought up some thing he feels we need to empathize is formalizing the data from 15,000 acre that has been inventoried with significant sites and use that to see the trend for the future sites as the Anticline grows .Clint asked the group what they thought and all agreed this would be a good tool .

10. To do this task would we need to hire someone to gather information ? Dave said BLM has annual reports on sites but would be inaccurate and it would take 2 to 3 weeks to get accurate report . First thing to get SHPO files and BLM files and then we need to put what data we need to formalize number of sites found over time and how they were disturbed .

11. BLM has ranked sites from significant to lesser . Would formalize data only on significant sites . Of three volumes of the RPM only three sections affects the Anticline sites . A report would give good information for the first six years of the Anticline on significant sites and non significant sites for future predictions of finds as Anticline continues to grow .

12. Dave Vlcek to mail Cultural Resource Report overview .

13. Monitoring plan of Lander Trail video that started in 2006 needs to be in place by Summer and have amended into RP by 2009 .

14. Jermy Wight has a non-profit organization called Lander Trail Foundation whose purpose is for education purposes and continue preservation of the Trail .

15. Newport Crossing for sale ( West side 10acres ) no historic value left , zoned residential .

16. One grant available from SHPO is Preserve America and Cultural Trust .

17. State Land Board will give SHPO chance to comment on development of State land.

18. Need to find \$2,500.00for Lander Trail monitoring video by June 2008 .
