Dear Reader:

The attached scoping notice provides a summary of a proposed 20-well pilot project submitted by Devon Energy Corporation (Devon) to the Lander Field Office of the Bureau of Land Management (BLM). The Proposed Action involves drilling 20 wells to determine the technical feasibility and recoverability of coal bed natural gas (CBNG) from coal seams in the Mesaverde formation. The Project Area for this pilot project is approximately nine miles southeast of Riverton, Wyoming in Sections 27 and 28; Section 33 E1/2 of NW/4, NE/4, N1/2 of SE/4; and Section 34 NW/4; in Township 34 North and Range 96 West in Fremont County.

Written comments on the proposed project will be accepted by the BLM until July 21, 2006. In addition, a public meeting to respond to questions and receive oral comments will be held on July 6, 2006 at the Holiday Inn in Riverton, Wyoming from 7 p.m. to 9 p.m. or until the last comment is received.
